## TORAH PORTION

**Exodus 13:17** And it came to pass, when Pharaoh had let the people go, that God led them not through the way of the land of the Philistines, although that was near, for God said, Lest peradventure the people repent when they see war, and they return to Egypt.

**Exodus 13:18** But God led the people about, through the way of the wilderness of the Red sea: And the children of Israel went up harnessed out of the land of Egypt.

**Exodus 13:19** And Moses took **the bones of Joseph** with him: For he had straitly sworn the children of Israel, saying, God will surely visit you, and ye shall carry up my bones away hence with you.

**Exodus 14:5-7** And it was told the king of Egypt that the people fled: And the heart of Pharaoh and of his servants was turned against the people, and they said, Why have we done this, that we have let Israel go from serving us? And he made ready his chariot, and took his people with him: And he took six hundred chosen chariots, and all the chariots of Egypt, and captains over every one of them.

**Exodus 14:10-12** And when Pharaoh drew nigh, the children of Israel lifted up their eyes, and, behold, the Egyptians marched after them, and they were sore afraid: And the children of Israel cried out unto the LORD. And they said unto Moses, Because there were no graves in Egypt, hast thou taken us away to die in the wilderness? Wherefore hast thou dealt thus with us, to carry us forth out of Egypt? Is not this the word that we did tell thee in Egypt, saying, Let us alone, that we may serve the Egyptians? For it had been better for us to serve the Egyptians, than that we should die in the wilderness.

**Exodus 14:13,14** And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which he will shew to you today: For the Egyptians whom ye have seen today, ye shall see them again no more forever. The LORD shall fight for you, and ye shall hold your peace.

**Exodus 14:15,16** And the LORD said unto Moses, Wherefore cries thou unto me? Speak unto the children of Israel, that they go forward: But lift thou up thy rod, and stretch out thine hand over the sea, and divide it: And the children of Israel shall go on dry ground through the midst of the sea.

**Exodus 14:19-21** And the angel of God, which went before the camp of Israel, removed and went behind them, and the pillar of the cloud went from before their face, and stood behind them: And it came between the camp of the Egyptians and the camp of Israel, and it was a cloud and darkness to them,

but it gave light by night to these: So that the one came not near the other all the night. And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and the LORD caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea dry land, and the waters were divided.

**Exodus 14:22,23** And the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea upon the dry ground: And the waters were a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left. And the Egyptians pursued, and went in after them to the midst of the sea, even all Pharaoh's horses, his chariots, and his horsemen.

**Exodus 14:26-28** And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch out thine hand over the sea, that the waters may come again upon the Egyptians, upon their chariots, and upon their horsemen. And Moses stretched forth his hand over the sea, and the sea returned to his strength when the morning appeared, and the Egyptians fled against it, and the LORD overthrew the Egyptians in the midst of the sea. And the waters returned, and covered the chariots, and the horsemen, and all the host of Pharaoh that came into the sea after them, there remained not so much as one of them.

**Exodus 14:29,30** But the children of Israel walked upon dry land in the midst of the sea, and the waters were a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left. Thus the LORD saved Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians, and Israel saw the Egyptians dead upon the sea shore.

**Exodus 15:1,2** Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the LORD, and spoke, saying, I will sing unto the LORD, for he hath triumphed gloriously: The horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea. The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation: He is my God, and I will prepare him an habitation, my father's God, and I will exalt him.

**Exodus 15:23-25** And when they came to Marah, they could not drink of the waters of Marah, for they were bitter: Therefore the name of it was called Marah. And the people murmured against Moses, saying, What shall we drink? And he cried unto the LORD, and the LORD shewed him a tree, which when he had cast into the waters, the waters were made sweet: There he made for them a statute and an ordinance, and there he proved them,

**Exodus 15:26** And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: For I am the LORD that healeth thee.

**Deuteronomy 15:1,2** At the end of every seven years there is to be a general forgiveness of debt. This is how it is to be done: Every creditor is to give up his right to whatever he has let his neighbor have, he is not to make his neighbor, his countryman, give it back, because a general forgiveness has been ordered by the Lord.

**Deuteronomy 15:7-9** If in any of your towns in the land which the Lord your God is giving you, there is a poor man, one of your countrymen, do not let your heart be hard or your hand shut to him, But let your hand be open to give him the use of whatever he is in need of. And see that there is no evil thought in your heart, moving you to say to yourself, The seventh year, the year of forgiveness is near, and so looking coldly on your poor countryman you give him nothing, and he will make an outcry to the Lord against you, and it will be judged as sin in you.

**Deuteronomy 15:10,11** But it is right for you to give to him, without grief of heart: For because of this, the blessing of the Lord your God will be on all your work and on everything to which you put your hand. For there will never be a time when there are no poor in the land, and so I give orders to you, Let your hand be open to your countrymen, to those who are poor and in need in your land.

**Matthew 26:7-13** There came to him a woman having a bottle of perfume of great price, and she put the perfume on his head when he was seated at table. But when the disciples saw it they were angry, saying, To what purpose is this waste? For we might have got much money for this and given it to the poor. But Jesus, seeing it, said to them, Why are you troubling the woman? She has done a kind act to me. For the poor you have ever with you, but me you have not forever. For in putting this perfume on my body, she did it to make me ready for my last resting-place. Truly I say to you, Wherever this good news goes out in all the world, what this woman has done will be talked of in memory of her.

**Deuteronomy 15:12-15** If one of your countrymen, a Hebrew man or woman, becomes your servant for a price and does work for you six years, in the seventh year let him go free. And when you make him free, do not let him go away with nothing in his hands: But give him freely from your flock and from your grain and your wine: In the measure of the wealth which the Lord your God has given you, you are to give to him. And keep in mind that you yourself were a servant in the land of Egypt, and the Lord your God made you free: So I give you this order today.

**Deuteronomy 16:1,2** Take note of the month of Abib and keep the Passover to the Lord your God: For in the month of Abib the Lord your God took you out of Egypt by night. The Passover offering, from your flock or your herd, is to be

given to the Lord your God in the place marked out by him as the resting-place of his name.

**Deuteronomy 16:16,17** Three times in the year let all your males come before the Lord your God in the place named by him, at the feast of unleavened bread, the feast of weeks, and the feast of tents: And they are not to come before the Lord with nothing in their hands, Every man is to give as he is able, in the measure of the blessing which the Lord your God has given you.

**2 Samuel 22:1-3** And David spoke unto the LORD the words of this song in the day that the LORD had delivered him out of the hand of all his enemies, and out of the hand of Saul: And he said, The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer, The God of my rock, in him will I trust: He is my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my Saviour, thou saves me from violence.

**Isaiah 11:1,2** And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots: And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.

**Isaiah 11:3,4** And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD: And he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears: But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: And he shall smite the earth **with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked.**

**Revelation 19:13-15** And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: And his name is called The Word of God. And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron: And he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

**Isaiah 11:6,7** The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid, and the calf and the young lion and the fatling together, and a little child shall lead them. And the cow and the bear shall feed, their young ones shall lie down together: And the lion shall eat straw like the ox.

**Isaiah 11:9,10** They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea. And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people, to it shall the Gentiles seek: And his rest shall be glorious.

**Isaiah 11:12** And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

**Zephaniah 3:20** At that time will I bring you again, even in the time that I gather you: For I will make you a name and a praise among all people of the earth, when I turn back your captivity before your eyes, saith the LORD.

**Isaiah 12:2,3** Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust, and not be afraid: For the LORD JEHOVAH is my strength and my song, he also is become my salvation. Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation.

**Isaiah 12:6** Cry out and shout, thou inhabitant of Zion: For great is the Holy One of Israel in the midst of thee.

**John 7:37,38** In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

### **The Life and Adventures of Shaliach Shaul The Writings to the Corinthians**

**Acts 18:1-3** After these things he departed from Athens, and came to Corinth. And he found a certain Jew named Aquila, a man of Pontus by race, lately come from Italy, with his wife Priscilla, because **Claudius had commanded all the Jews to depart from Rome**: And he came unto them, and because he was of the same trade, he abode with them, and they wrought, for by their trade they were tentmakers.

**Acts 18:4,5** And he reasoned in the synagogue every Sabbath, and tried to persuade Jews and Greeks. When Silas and Timothy arrived from Macedonia, Paul was occupied with the word, testifying to the Jews that the Messiah was Yeshua.

**Acts 18:6,7** And when they opposed and reviled him, he shook out his garments and said to them, Your blood be on your own heads! I am innocent. From now on I will go to the Gentiles. And he left there and went to the house of a man named Titius Justus, a worshiper of God. His house was next door to the synagogue.

**Acts 18:8-11** Crispus, the ruler of the synagogue, believed in the Lord, together with his entire household. And many of the Corinthians hearing Paul believed and were baptized. And the Lord said to Paul one night in a vision, Do not be afraid, but go on speaking and do not be silent, for I am with you, and no

one will attack you to harm you, for I have many in this city who are my people. And he stayed **a year and six months**, teaching the word of God among them.

**Acts 18:12,13** But when Gallio was proconsul of Achaia, the Jews made a united attack on Paul and brought him before the tribunal, saying, This man is persuading people to worship God contrary to the law.

**Acts 18:15-17** But since it is a matter of questions about words and names and your own law, see to it yourselves. I refuse to be a judge of these things. And he drove them from the tribunal. And **they all seized Sosthenes, the ruler of the synagogue**, and **beat him** in front of the tribunal. But Gallio paid no attention to any of this.

**HHBNT 1 Corinthians 1:1,2** Paul, called to be an authoritative emissary of Yeshua, the Anointed One, by the will of God, and **Sosthenes our brother**, to the congregation of God which is located at Corinth, to those who have been made holy in the Anointed One, Yeshua, righteous ones by being called, together with all who in every place pray by calling upon the name of our Lord Yeshua, the Anointed One, both their [Master] and ours.

**HHBNT 1 Corinthians 1:10,11** Now I encourage you, brothers and sisters, by the name of our Lord Yeshua, the Anointed One, that you all agree and that there be no divided factions among you, but rather that you be united together with the same like-minded attitude and the same common opinion. After all, I have been informed concerning you, my brothers and sisters, **by Chloe's people**, that there are quarrels among you.

**HHBNT 1 Corinthians 1:12** So then, what I mean by this is that each one of you is claiming, I have sided with Paul, or I have sided with Apollos, or I have sided with Kefa, and also, I belong to the Anointed One.

**Isaiah 44:5** This one will say, I am the LORD'S, another will call on the name of Jacob, and another will write on his hand, The LORD'S, and name himself by the name of Israel.

**1 Corinthians 1:14,15** I thank God that I baptized none of you **except Crispus and Gaius**, so that no one may say that you were baptized in my name.

**Acts 19:28,29** When they heard this they were enraged and were crying out, Great is Artemis of the Ephesians! So the city was filled with the confusion, and they rushed together into the theater, dragging with them **Gaius** and Aristarchus, Macedonians who were Paul's companions in travel.

**3 John 1:1-3** The elder to the **beloved Gaius**, whom I love in truth. Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you and that you may be in good health, as it goes well with your soul. For I rejoiced greatly when the brothers came and testified to your truth, as indeed you are walking in the truth.

**TCNT 1 Corinthians 1:17-25** My mission from Christ was not to baptize, but to tell the Good News, not, however, in the language of philosophy, lest the cross of the Christ should be robbed of its meaning. The Message of the Cross is indeed mere folly to those who are in the path to Ruin, but to us who are in the path of Salvation it is the very power of God. For Scripture says, I will bring the philosophy of the philosophers to naught, and the shrewdness of the shrewd I will make of no account. Where is the Philosopher? Where the Teacher of the Law? Where the Disputant of to-day? Has not God shown the world's philosophy to be folly? For since the world, in God's wisdom, did not by its philosophy learn to know God, God saw fit, by the folly of our proclamation, to save those who believe in Messiah! While **Jews ask for miraculous signs, and Greeks study philosophy**, We are **proclaiming Messiah crucified! To the Jews an obstacle, to the Gentiles mere folly**, But to those who have received the Call, whether Jews or Greeks, Messiah, the Power of God and the Wisdom of God! For God's folly is wiser than men, and God's weakness is stronger than men.

**Isaiah 55:8,9** For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.

**Isaiah 53:9** And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death, because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth.

**Psalms 16:10** For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

**Psalms 110:1** The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.

**Daniel 7:13,14** I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

**Matthew 11:4,5** And Yeshua, answering, said to them, Go and give news to John of the things which you are seeing and hearing: The blind see, those who were not able to, are walking, lepers are made clean, those who were without hearing,



now have their ears open, the dead come to life again, and the poor have the good news given to them.

**Matthew 24:24** For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders, insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

**1 Corinthians 1:26-29** For consider your calling, brothers: Not many of you were wise according to worldly standards, not many were powerful, not many were of noble birth. But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise, God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong, God chose what is low and despised in the world, even things that are not, to bring to nothing things that are, so that no human being might boast in the presence of God.

**1 Corinthians 1:31** so that, as it is written, Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord.

**Jeremiah 9:23,24** Thus says the LORD: Let not the wise man boast in his wisdom, let not the mighty man boast in his might, let not the rich man boast in his riches, but let him who boasts boast in this, that he understands and knows me, that I am the LORD who practices steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth. For in these things I delight, declares the LORD.

**James 3:13-18** Who has wisdom and good sense among you? Let him make his works clear by a life of gentle wisdom. But if you have bitter envy in your heart and the desire to get the better of others, have no pride in this, talking falsely against what is true. This wisdom is not from heaven, but is of the earth and the flesh and the Evil One. For where envy is, and the desire to get the better of others, there is no order, but every sort of evildoing. But the wisdom which is from heaven is first holy, then gentle, readily giving way in argument, full of peace and mercy and good works, not doubting, not seeming other than it is. And the fruit of righteousness is planted in peace for those who make peace.

**1 Corinthians 2:6-8** Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: Yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to naught: But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even **the hidden wisdom**, which God ordained before the world unto our glory: Which none of the princes of this world knew: For had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

**1 Corinthians 2:9-11** But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: For the Spirit

searched all things, yea, the deep things of God. For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? Even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

**Isaiah 64:4** For since the beginning of the world men have not heard, nor perceived by the ear, neither hath the eye seen, O God, beside thee, what he hath prepared for him that waiteth for him.

**1 Corinthians 2:12** Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit, which is of God, that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

**Deuteronomy 29:29** The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: But those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.

**1 Corinthians 2:13-16** So then we teach these truths, not ever expressed in words of human wisdom, but taught by the Spirit to those who are led by the Spirit, spiritual wisdom applied through discernment. A worldly-minded individual does not embrace the teachings from the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and such an individual cannot understand them because they are spiritually discerned. The one who is Spirit-led, however, discerns all spiritual matters but is not judged by anyone. After all, Who has known the mind of the LORD, **so that a mere mortal would teach Him?** We, however, have the mind of the Anointed One.

**Isaiah 40:13-15** Who hath directed the Spirit of the LORD, or being his counsellor hath taught him? With whom took he counsel, and who instructed him, and taught him in the path of judgment, and taught him knowledge, and shewed to him the way of understanding? Behold, the nations are as a drop of a bucket, and are counted as the small dust of the balance: Behold, he taketh up the isles as a very little thing.

**1 Corinthians 3:1-3** And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ. I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: For hitherto ye were not able to bear it, neither yet now are ye able. For ye are yet carnal: For whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?

**Hebrews 5:12-14** For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God, and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. For every one that useth milk is unskillful in the word of righteousness: For he is a babe. But strong

meat belongs to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

**1 Corinthians 3:4,5** For while one saith, I am of Paul, and another, I am of Apollos, are ye not carnal? Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers by whom ye believed, even as the Lord gave to every man? I have planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase.

**HHBNT 1 Corinthians 3:10-13** According to the grace of God which was given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation. Another servant, however, is building upon it. But each servant must use extreme caution how he builds. After all, no one can lay any other foundation than the one which is laid, which is Yeshua, the Anointed One. Now if any person builds on the foundation with gold, silver, costly stones, wood, hay, or straw, **each individual's work will become evident, because the dawning of that day will make it visible when everything will be revealed by fire.** The fire itself will test what kind of quality went into each builder's construction project.

**1 Corinthians 3:14-17** If a person's own construction project, which that builder worked to create, survives the fire, that person will receive a reward. If a person's building project is destroyed by the fire, that builder will suffer the severe loss, even though this individual will indeed be saved, like someone escaping from a fire. Do you not realize that you are the Temple of God and the Spirit of God lives inside of you? If any person destroys the Temple of God, God will destroy that person. After all, the Temple of God is holy, and that Temple is who you are.

**HHBNT 1 Corinthians 3:18-21** Do not let anyone be self-deceived. If any person among you considers himself wise in this age, that one must become foolish in order to become wise. The wisdom of this world system is foolishness to God, as it stands written, He catches the wise in their own human reasoning and in another passage, The LORD knows the thought processes of the wise, that they are futile"(Ps 94:11). So then, do not let anyone brag about human achievement. After all, everything belongs to you.

**Job 5:13,14** He taketh the wise in their own craftiness: And the counsel of the froward is carried headlong. They meet with darkness in the daytime, and grope in the noonday as in the night.

**Revelation 22:12** Behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward *is* with Me, to reward each one as his work <sup>is</sup>deserves.
