TORAH PORTION

Deuteronomy 1:1a These are the words which Moses spake unto all Israel on this side Jordan in the wilderness.

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Proverbs 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue.

Psalm 34:12,13 Who is the man who desires life, and loves many days, that he may see good? Keep your tongue from evil, and your lips from speaking deceit.

Ephesians 4:29,31 Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear. Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice.

Deuteronomy 1:34,35 And the Lord heard the voice of your words, and was wroth, and sware, saying, Surely there shall not one of these men of this evil generation see that good land, which I sware to give unto your fathers.

Deuteronomy 1:2,3 (There are eleven days' journey from Horeb by the way of Mount Seir unto Kadesh-Barnea.) And it came to pass in the fortieth year, in the eleventh month, on the first day of the month, that Moses spake unto the children of Israel, according unto all that the Lord had given him in commandment unto them.

Deuteronomy 4:23 Take heed unto yourselves, lest ye forget the covenant of the LORD your God, which he made with you, and make you a graven image, or the likeness of any thing, which the LORD thy God hath forbidden thee.

Deuteronomy 4:9-13 Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, lest thou forget the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life: But **teach them thy sons, and thy sons' sons, Especially the day that thou stoodest before the LORD** thy God in Horeb, when the LORD said unto me, Gather me the people together, and I will make them hear my words, that they may learn to fear me all the days that they shall live upon the earth, and that they may teach their children. And ye came near and stood under the mountain, and the mountain burned with fire unto

the midst of heaven, with darkness, clouds, and thick darkness. And the **LORD spake unto you out of the midst of the fire: Ye heard the voice of the words**, but saw no similitude, only ye heard a voice. And **he declared unto you his covenant**, which he commanded you to perform, **even ten commandments, and he wrote them upon two tables of stone.**

Deuteronomy 5:15 And remember that thou wast a servant in the land of Egypt, and that the LORD thy God brought thee out thence through a mighty hand and by a stretched out arm: Therefore the LORD thy God commanded thee to keep the sabbath day.

Deuteronomy 7:17-19 If thou shalt say in thine heart, These nations are more than I, how can I dispossess them? Thou shalt **not be afraid of them**: But **shalt well remember what the LORD thy God did unto Pharaoh, and unto all Egypt**, The great temptations which thine eyes saw, and the signs, and the wonders, and the mighty hand, and the stretched out arm, whereby the LORD thy God brought thee out: So shall the LORD thy God do unto all the people of whom thou art afraid.

Deuteronomy 8:2 And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no.

Deuteronomy 9:7 Remember, and forget not, how thou provokedst the LORD thy God to wrath in the wilderness: From the day that thou didst depart out of the land of Egypt, until ye came unto this place, ye have been rebellious against the LORD.

Deuteronomy 24:9 Remember what the LORD thy God did unto Miriam by the way, after that ye were come forth out of Egypt.

Deuteronomy 32:7-8 Remember the days of old, consider the years of many generations: Ask thy father, and he will shew thee, thy elders, and they will tell thee. When the most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel.

Deuteronomy 7:6-9 For you are an holy people unto the LORD your God: The LORD your God hath **chosen you to be a special people unto himself**, above all people that are upon the face of the earth. The LORD did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were

more in number than any people, for ye were the fewest of all people: But **because the LORD loved you**, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt. Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, **the faithful God**, which **keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations**.

Deuteronomy 1:22,23 And you came near to me every one of you, and said, We will send men before us, and they shall search us out the land, and bring us word again by similitude, only ye heard a voice. And he what way we must go up, and into what cities we shall come. And the saying pleased me well: And I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe.

Deuteronomy 1:27 And ye murmured in your tents, and said, **Because the Lord hated us**, he hath brought us forth out of the land of Egypt, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us.

Matthew 25:24 Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew you that you are an hard man, reaping where you have not sown, and gathering where you have not strewed.

Deuteronomy 1:29,30 Then I said unto you, Dread not, neither be afraid of them. The Lord your God which goeth before you, he shall fight for you, according to all that he did for you in Egypt before your eyes.

Deuteronomy 1:31-32 And in the wilderness, where thou hast seen how that the Lord thy God bare thee, as a man doth bear his son, in all the way that ye went, until ye came into this place. Yet in this thing ye did not believe the Lord your God.

Deuteronomy 1:32-35 Yet in this thing **you did not believe** the LORD your God, Who went in the way before you, to search you out a place to pitch your tents in, in fire by night, to show you by what way you should go, and in a cloud by day. And the LORD heard **the voice of your words**, and was wroth, and sware, saying, Surely there shall not one of these men of this **evil generation** see that good land, which I sware to give unto your fathers.

Deuteronomy 1:39 Moreover **your little ones, that ye said should be a prey**, and your children, that this day have no knowledge of good

or evil, they shall go in thither, and unto them will I give it, and they shall possess it.

Deuteronomy 1:45 And ye returned and wept before the Lord, but the Lord would not hearken to your voice, nor give ear unto you.

Deuteronomy 2:4,5 And command thou the people, saying, Ye are to pass through the coast of your brethren the **children of Esau**, which dwell in Seir, and they shall be afraid of you: Take ye good heed unto yourselves therefore: **Meddle not with them**, for I will not give you of their land, no, not so much as a foot breadth, because I have given mount Seir unto Esau for a possession.

Deuteronomy 2:9 And the Lord said unto me, **Distress not the Moabites**, neither contend with them in battle: For I will not give thee of their land for a possession, because I have given Ar unto the children of Lot for a possession.

Deuteronomy 2:19 And when thou comest nigh over against the children of **Ammon**, **distress them not**, nor meddle with them: For I will not give thee of the land of the children of Ammon any possession, because I have given it unto the children of Lot for a possession.

Deuteronomy 2:10 The Emims dwelt therein in times past, a people great, and many, and tall, as the Anakims, Which also were accounted giants, as the Anakims, but the Moabites call them Emims.

Deuteronomy 2:12 The Horims also dwelt in Seir beforetime, but the children of Esau succeeded them, when they had destroyed them from before them, and dwelt in their stead, as Israel did unto the land of his possession, which the Lord gave unto them.

Deuteronomy 2:20-21 (That also was accounted a land of giants: Giants dwelt therein in old time, and the Ammonites call them Zamzummims, A people great, and many, and tall, as the Anakims, but the Lord destroyed them before them; and they succeeded them, and dwelt in their stead.

Isaiah 1:1-4 The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem, in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, and Hezekiah, kings of Judah. Hear, heavens, and listen, earth, for the LORD has spoken: I have nourished and brought up children, and **they have rebelled against me**.

The ox knows his owner, and the donkey his master's crib, but Israel doesn't know, my people don't consider. Ah sinful nation, a people loaded with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children who deal corruptly! They have forsaken the LORD. They have despised the Holy One of Israel. They are estranged and backward.

The Calendar Systems

Revelation 12:3 And another sign appeared **in heaven**: Behold, a great **red dragon**, with seven heads and ten horns, and on his heads seven diadems.

Revelation 12:7-9 Now war arose **in heaven**, Michael and his angels fighting against the dragon. And the **dragon** and his angels fought back, but he was defeated, and there was no longer any place for them in heaven. And the great dragon was thrown down, that **ancient serpent**, who is called **the devil and Satan**, the deceiver of the whole world—he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

Revelation 9:16,17 The number of mounted troops was **twice ten thousand times ten thousand**, I heard their number. And this is how I saw the horses in my vision and those who rode them: They wore breastplates the color of fire and of sapphire and of sulfur, and the heads of the horses were like lions' heads, and fire and smoke and sulfur came out of their mouths.

Revelation 14:1,2 Then I looked, and behold, on Mount Zion **stood the Lamb**, and with him 144,000 who had his name and his Father's name written on their foreheads. And I heard a voice from heaven like the roar of many waters and like the sound of loud thunder.

Genesis 1:14 And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night, and let **them** be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and **years**.

Deuteronomy 16:1 Take note of the month of Abib(Spring) and keep the Passover to the Lord your God: For in the month of Abib the Lord your God took you out of Egypt by night.

Exodus 12:1,2 And the Lord said to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, Let this month be to you the first of months, the first month of the year.

1Chronicles 28:11-13 Then David gave Solomon his son the plan of the vestibule of the temple, and of its houses, its treasuries, its upper rooms, and its inner chambers, and of the room for the mercy seat, and the plan of all that he had in mind for the courts of the house of the LORD, all the surrounding chambers, the treasuries of the house of God, and the treasuries for dedicated gifts, **for the divisions of the priests** and of the Levites, and all the work of the service in the house of the LORD, for all the vessels for the service in the house of the LORD.

1Kings 9:26 King Solomon built a fleet of ships at Ezion-geber, which is near Elath on the shore of the Red Sea, in the land of Edom. And Hiram sent with the fleet his servants, seamen who were familiar with the sea, together with the servants of Solomon. And they went to Ophir and brought from there gold, 420 talents, and they brought it to King Solomon.

1Kings 10:24,25 And the whole earth sought the presence of Solomon to hear his wisdom, which God had put into his mind. Every one of them brought his present, articles of silver and gold, garments, myrrh, spices, horses, and mules, so much year by year.

2Samuel 11:1 In the spring of the year, the time when kings go out to battle, David sent Joab, and his servants with him, and all Israel. And they ravaged the Ammonites and besieged Rabbah. But David remained at Jerusalem.

Acts 18:1,2 After this Paul left Athens and went to Corinth. And he found a Jew named Aquila, a native of Pontus, recently come from Italy with his wife Priscilla, because Claudius had commanded all the Jews to leave Rome. And he went to see them.

Genesis 15:16 And they shall come back here in the fourth generation, for the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet complete.

Genesis 46:8 Now these are the names of the descendants of Israel, who came into Egypt, Jacob and his sons. Reuben, Jacob's firstborn.

Genesis 46:11 The sons of Levi: Gershon, Kohath, and Merari.

Exodus 6:16 These are the names of the sons of Levi according to their generations: Gershon, Kohath, and Merari, the years of the life of Levi being 137 years.

Exodus 6:18 The sons of Kohath: Amram, Izhar, Hebron, and Uzziel, the years of the life of **Kohath** being **133 years**.

Exodus 6:20 Amram took as his wife Jochebed his father's sister, and she bore him Aaron and **Moses**, the years of the life of **Amram** being **137 years**.

Ecclesiastes 3:1 To everything there is a season, and a **time to every purpose** under the heaven.

Genesis 7:4-6 For yet seven days, and I will cause it to rain upon the earth forty days and forty nights, and every living substance that I have made will I destroy from off the face of the earth. And Noah did according unto all that the LORD commanded him. And Noah was **six hundred** years old when the flood of waters was upon the earth.

Genesis 7:16 And they that went in, went in male and female of all flesh, as God had commanded him: And the LORD shut him in.

Ecclesiastes 3:16,17 And moreover I saw under the sun the place of judgment, that wickedness was there, and the place of righteousness, that iniquity was there. I said in mine heart, God shall judge the righteous and the wicked: For **there is a time there for every purpose and for every work**.

Galatians 4:4 But when the **fulness of the time** was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.

Isaiah 14:24-27 The Lord has taken an oath, saying, My design will certainly come about, and my purpose will be effected: To let the Assyrian be broken in my land, and crushed under foot on my mountains: There will his yoke be taken away from them, and his rule over them come to an end. This is the purpose for all the earth: And this is the hand stretched out over all nations. For it is the purpose of the Lord of armies, and who will make it of no effect? When his hand is stretched out, by whom may it be turned back?

Ephesians 1:9 Having made clear to us **the secret of his purpose**, in agreement with the **design which he had in mind**, to put into His hands the ordering of the times when they are complete, so that all things might come to a head in Messiah, the things in heaven and the things on the earth, in him, I say, In whom we have a heritage, being

marked out **from the first in his purpose who does all things in agreement with his designs.**
