## TORAH PORTION

**Deuteronomy 21:10** When you go to war against your enemies.

**Deuteronomy 21:15-17** *If a man have two wives, one beloved, and another hated, and they have born him children, both the beloved and the hated, and if the firstborn son be hers that was hated: Then it shall be, when he makes his sons to inherit that which he has, that he may not make the son of the beloved firstborn before the son of the hated, which is indeed the firstborn: But he shall acknowledge the son of the hated for the firstborn, by giving him a double portion of all that he hath for he is the beginning of his strength.*

**Deuteronomy 22:1-3** You shall not see your brother's ox or his sheep go astray, and hide yourself from them: You shall in any case bring them again to your brother. And if your brother be not near to you, or if you know him not, then you shall bring it to your own house, and it shall be with you until your brother seek after it, and you shall restore it to him again. In like manner shall you do with his ass, and **so shall you do with his raiment**, and **with all lost things** of your brother's, which he has lost, and you have found, shall you do likewise: You may not hide yourself.

**Exodus 23:5** If you see the ass of him that hates you lying under his burden, and would forbear to help him, you shall surely help with him.

**Deuteronomy 22:4** You shall not see your brother's ass or his ox fall down by the way, and hide yourself from them: You shall surely help him to lift them up again.

**Deuteronomy 22:6,7** If a bird's nest chance to be before you in the way in any tree, or on the ground, whether they be young ones, or eggs, and the dam sitting on the young, or on the eggs, you shall not take the dam with the young: But you shall in any wise let the dam go, and take the young to you, that it may be well with you, and **that you may prolong your days**.

**Luke 13:34,35** Jerusalem, Jerusalem, that kills the prophets, and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, like a hen gathers her own brood under her wings, and you refused! Behold, your house is left to you desolate. I tell you, you will not see me, until you say, Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!

**Deuteronomy 22:8** When you build a new house, then you shall make a battlement for your roof, that you bring not blood on your house, if any man fall from there.

**Deuteronomy 23:7,8** You shall not abhor an Edomite, for he is your brother! You shall not abhor an Egyptian, because you were a stranger in his land. The children that are begotten of them shall enter into the congregation of the LORD in their third generation.

**Deuteronomy 23:21–23** When you shall vow a vow to the LORD your God, you shall not slack to pay it: For the LORD your God will surely require it of you, and it would be sin in you. But if you shall forbear to vow, it shall be no sin in you. That which is gone out of your lips you shall keep and perform, even a freewill offering, according as you have vowed to the LORD your God, which you have promised with your mouth.

**Deuteronomy 23:24,25** When you come into your neighbor's vineyard, then you may eat grapes your fill at your own pleasure, but you shall not put any in your vessel. When you come into the standing corn of your neighbor, then you may pluck the ears with your hand, but you shall not move a sickle to your neighbor's standing corn.

**Matthew 12:1,2** At that time, Yeshua went on the Sabbath day through the grain fields. His disciples were hungry and began to pluck heads of grain and to eat. But the Pharisees, when they saw it, said to him, Behold, your disciples do what is not lawful to do on the Sabbath.

**Deuteronomy 24:9** Remember what the LORD your God did to Miriam by the way, after that you were come forth out of Egypt.

**Proverbs 18:21** Death and life are in the power of the tongue: And they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

**Proverbs 15:2-4** The tongue of the wise uses knowledge aright: but the mouth of fools pours out foolishness. The eyes of the LORD are in every place, beholding the evil and the good. A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: But perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit.

**Deuteronomy 24:14,15** You shall not oppress an hired servant that is poor and needy, whether he be of your brothers, or of your strangers that are in your land within your gates: At his day you shall give him his hire, neither shall the sun go down on it, for he is poor, and sets his heart on it: Lest he cry against you to the LORD, and it be sin to you.

**Deuteronomy 24:19-22** When you cut down your harvest in your field, and have forgot a sheaf in the field, you shall not go again to fetch it: It shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow: That the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hands. When you beat your olive tree,

you shall not go over the boughs again: It shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow. When you gather the grapes of your vineyard, you shall not glean it afterward: It shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow. And you shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt: Therefore I command you to do this thing.

**Deuteronomy 25:4** You shall not muzzle the ox when he treads out the corn.

**1 Timothy 5:17,18** Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honor, especially they who labor in the word and doctrine. For the scripture said, You shall **not muzzle the ox that treads out the corn.** And, the laborer is worthy of his reward.

**Deuteronomy 25:15,16** You shall have a perfect and just weight, a perfect and just measure, that your days may be lengthened in the land which the LORD your God is giving you. For all who do such things, all who behave unrighteously, are an abomination to the LORD your God.

**Deuteronomy 25:17-19** Remember what Amalek did to you by the way, when you were come forth out of Egypt, How he met you by the way, and smote the hindmost of you, even all that were feeble behind you, when you were faint and weary, and he feared not God. Therefore it shall be, when the LORD your God has given you rest from all your enemies round about, in the land which the LORD your God gives you for an inheritance to possess it, that you shall blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven, you shall not forget it.

**Isaiah 54:1-3** Sing, O barren, you that did not bear, break forth into singing, and cry aloud, you that did not travail with child: For more are the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, said the LORD. Enlarge the place of your tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of your habitations: Spare not, lengthen your cords, and strengthen your stakes, For you shall break forth on the right hand and on the left, and your seed shall inherit the Gentiles, and make the desolate cities to be inhabited.

**Isaiah 54:5-7** For your Maker is your husband, the LORD of hosts is his name, and your Redeemer the Holy One of Israel, The God of the whole earth shall he be called. For the LORD has called you as a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, and a wife of youth, when you were refused, said your God. For a small moment have I forsaken you, but with great mercies will I gather you.

**Isaiah 54:8-10** In a little wrath I hid my face from you for a moment, but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on you, said the LORD your Redeemer.

For this is **as the waters of Noah** to me: For as I have sworn that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth, so have I sworn that I would not be wroth with you, nor rebuke you. For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed, but my kindness shall not depart from you, **neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed, said the LORD that has mercy on you.**

**Malachi 3:7** Even from the days of your fathers ye are gone away from mine ordinances, and have not kept them. **Return unto me, and I will return unto you,** saith the LORD of hosts.

**Matthew 24:27,28** For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. For wheresoever the carcase is, there will the eagles be gathered together.

**Matthew 24:7** For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: And there shall be famines, and pestilences, and **earthquakes,** in divers places.

**Matthew 24:32-34** Now learn a parable of the fig tree, When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh: So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors. Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled.

## DECODING ZECHARIAH

**Zechariah 3:3,4** Now Joshua was clothed with filthy garments, and stood before the angel. And he answered and spoke unto those that stood before him, saying: Take the filthy garments from off him. And unto him he said: Behold, I cause thine iniquity to pass from thee, and I will clothe thee with robes.

**Jude 1:21-23** Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. And of some have compassion, making a difference: And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire, **hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.**

**Galatians 5:19-21** Now the works of the flesh are evident: Sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things **will not** inherit the kingdom of God.

**Isaiah 4:3,4** And it shall come to pass, that he that is left in Zion, and he that remaineth in Jerusalem, shall be called holy, even every one that is **written**

**unto life** in Jerusalem, When the Lord shall have **washed away the filth** of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof, by the spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of destruction.

**Isaiah 4:5,6** Then the LORD will create over every dwelling place on Mount Zion and over her **assemblies a cloud by day**, and smoke and the shining of a **flaming fire** by night, for over all the glory there will be a **canopy**. There will be a **booth** for shade by day from the heat, and for a refuge and a shelter from the storm and rain.

**Ezekiel 36:24-29** **I will** take you from the nations and gather you from all the countries and bring you into your own land. **I will** sprinkle clean water on you, and you **shall be clean from all your uncleannesses**, and from all your idols **I will** cleanse you. And **I will** give you a new heart, and a new spirit **I will** put within you. And **I will** remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. And **I will** put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules. You shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, and you shall be my people, and **I will** be your God. And **I will** deliver you from all your uncleannesses. And **I will** summon the grain and make it abundant and lay no famine upon you.

**Zechariah 3:5** And I said, Let them set a **clean mitre upon his head**. So they set a clean mitre upon his head, and clothed him with garments, and the angel of Jehovah was standing by.

**Isaiah 61:10** I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall exult in my God, for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation, he has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself **like a priest with a beautiful headdress**, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

**Exodus 28:36-38** And thou shalt make a plate of pure gold, **and engrave upon it**, like the **engravings of a signet: HOLY TO THE LORD**. And thou shalt put it on a thread of blue, and it shall be upon the mitre, upon the forefront of the mitre it shall be. And it shall be upon Aaron's forehead, and Aaron shall bear the iniquity committed in the holy things, which the children of Israel shall hallow, even in all their holy gifts, and it shall be always upon his forehead, that **they may be accepted before the LORD**.

**Isaiah 64:6** And we are all become as one that is unclean, and all our righteousnesses are as a polluted garment; and we all do fade as a leaf, and our iniquities, **like the wind, take us away**.

**Psalms 103:15,16** As for man, his days are as grass: His beautiful growth is like the flower of the field. **The wind goes over it and it is gone;** and its place sees it no longer.

**Psalms 103:117-20** But the mercy of the Lord is eternal for his worshippers, and their children's children will see his righteousness, If they keep his agreement, and **have his laws in mind to do them.** The Lord has made ready his high seat in the heavens, his kingdom is ruling over all. Give praise to the Lord, **you his angels, who are great in strength, doing his orders, and waiting for his voice.**

**Philippians 2:5-7** Let this mind be in you which was in Christ Jesus, To whom, though himself in the form of God, it did not seem that to take for oneself was to be like God, But he made himself as nothing, taking **the form of a servant,** being made like men.

**Zechariah 3:6,7** And the angel of the LORD protested unto Joshua, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, If you will walk in **My ways,** and if you will keep **My charge,** then you shall also judge **My house,** and shall also keep **My courts,** and I will give you places **to walk among these that stand by.**

**Zechariah 3:6,7** And the angel of the LORD protested unto Joshua, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, If you will walk in **My ways,** and if you will keep **My charge,** then you shall also not only have the honor of judging **My house,** and keeping **My courts,** but when your work on earth is done and you have been transplanted to a higher service I will give you places **to walk among these angelic beings that stand by Me earnestly waiting to fulfill My word.**

**2 Chronicles 23:19** And he put door-keepers at the doors of the Lord's house, to see that no one who was unclean in any way might come in.

**2 Corinthians 5:9,10** For this reason we make it our purpose, in the body or away from it, to be well-pleasing to him. For we all have to come before Christ to be judged, so that every one of us may get his reward **for the things done** in the body, good or bad.

**Zechariah 3:8-10** Give ear now, O Joshua, the high priest, you and your friends who are seated before you, for these are men who are a sign: **For see,** I will let **My servant the Branch** be seen. **For see, the stone** which I have put before Joshua, on **one stone are seven eyes:** Behold, **I will engrave the graving** thereof says the Lord of armies, and **I will take away the sin of that land in one day.** In that day, says the Lord of armies, you will be one another's guests under the vine and under the fig-tree.

**Isaiah 11:1** And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a **Branch shall grow out of his roots.**

**Isaiah 42:1-4** Behold My servant, whom I uphold, my chosen, in whom my soul delights, **I have put my Spirit upon him**, he will bring forth justice to the nations. He will not cry aloud or lift up his voice, or make it heard in the street, a bruised reed he will not break, and a faintly burning wick he will not quench, he will **faithfully bring forth justice**. He will not grow faint or be discouraged till he has established justice in the earth, and the **coastlands wait for his law.**

**Jeremiah 23:5,6** Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a **righteous Branch, and a King** shall reign and prosper, and shall **execute judgment and justice in the earth**. In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: And **this is his name** whereby **he shall be called**, **THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.**

**Isaiah 49:5,6** And now saith the LORD that formed Me from the womb to be **His servant**, to bring Jacob back to Him, and that Israel be gathered unto Him--for I am honorable in the eyes of the LORD, and my God is become my strength-- Yea, He saith: It is too light a thing that thou shouldest be **My servant** to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the offspring of Israel, **I will also give You for a light of the nations, that My salvation may be unto the end of the earth.**

**Jeremiah 33:14-16** Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will perform that good thing which I have promised unto the house of Israel and to the house of Judah. In those days, and at that time, will I cause **the Branch** of righteousness to grow up unto David, and he shall execute judgment and righteousness in the land. In those days shall Judah be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely: And this is the name wherewith **she shall be called, The LORD our righteousness.**

**Zechariah 6:12,13** And speak unto him, saying, Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, saying, **Behold the man** whose name is **The BRANCH**, and he shall grow up out of his place, **and he shall build the temple** of the LORD: Even he shall build the temple of the LORD, and he shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon his throne, and he **shall be a priest upon his throne**: And the counsel of peace shall be between them both.

**John 2:19** Jesus answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.

**John 19:1** Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged him. And the soldiers platted a crown of thorns, and put it on his head, and they put on him a purple robe.

**John 19:5** Then came Jesus forth, wearing the crown of thorns, and the purple robe. And Pilate saith unto them, **Behold the man!**

**John 19:7** The Jews answered him, We have a law, and by our law he ought to die, because he made himself **the Son of God.**

**John 19:14** And it was the preparation of the Passover, and about the sixth hour: And he saith unto the Jews, **Behold your King!**

**John 19:19** And Pilate wrote a title, and put it on the cross. And the writing was, JESUS OF NAZARETH THE KING OF THE JEWS.

**Matthew 1:1** The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, **the son of David.**

**Luke 3:38** which was the **son of Adam.**

**Mark 9:35** And he sat down, and called the twelve, and saith unto them, If any man desire to be first, the same shall be last of all, **and servant of all.**

**John 8:58** Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **Before Abraham was, I am.**

**Micah 5:2** But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel, whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

**John 1:1** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

**Exodus 23:20,21** Behold, I send an Angel before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared. Beware of him, and obey his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your transgressions: For **My name is in him.**

**Isaiah 28:16,17** Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation **a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner stone, a sure foundation:** He that believeth shall not make haste. Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: And the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place.

**Revelation 1:12-14** And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven **golden candlesticks**, And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle. His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow, and his eyes were as a flame of fire.

**Revelation 4:5** And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunders and voices: And there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, **which are the seven Spirits of God.**

**Revelation 5:6** And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and **seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God** sent forth into all the earth.

**Isaiah 11:2** And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.
