TORAH PORTION

Deuteronomy 29:10-15 You stand today, all of you, before the LORD your God, your captains of your tribes, your elders, and your officers, all the men of Israel, your little ones, your wives, and your **stranger** that is in your camp, from the cutter of your wood to the drawer of your water, so that **you should enter into covenant** with the LORD your God, and into His oath, which the LORD your God makes you today, that He may establish you today for a people to Himself, and that He may be a God to you, as He has said to you, and as He has sworn to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob. Nor do I make this covenant and this oath with you only, but with him who stands here with us today before the LORD our God, **and also with him that is not here with us today.**

Deuteronomy 29:16-19 (For ye know how we have dwelt in the land of Egypt, and how we came through the nations which ye passed by, And ye have seen their abominations, and their idols, wood and stone, silver and gold, which were among them:) Lest there should be among you man, or woman, or family, or tribe, whose heart turneth away this day from the LORD our God, to go and serve the gods of these nations, lest there should be among you a root that beareth gall and wormwood, And it come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, I shall have peace, though I walk in the imagination of mine heart, to add drunkenness to thirst.

Deuteronomy 29:20,21 The LORD will not spare him, but then the anger of the LORD and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the LORD shall blot out his name from under heaven. And the LORD shall separate him unto evil out of all the tribes of Israel, according to all the curses of the covenant that are written in this book of the law.

Deuteronomy 29:24-28 Even all nations shall say, Wherefore hath the LORD done thus unto this land? What meaneth the heat of this great anger? Then men shall say, Because they have forsaken the covenant of the LORD God of their fathers, which he made with them when he brought them forth out of the land of Egypt: For they went and served other gods, and worshipped them, gods whom they knew not, and whom he had not given unto them: And the anger of the LORD was kindled against this land, to bring upon it all the curses that are written in this book: And the LORD **rooted them** out of their land in anger, and in wrath, and in great indignation, and **cast them** into another land, as it is this day.

Deuteronomy 29:29 The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: But those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.

Deuteronomy 30:1 And it shall be when all these things have come on you, the blessing and the curse which I have set before you, and when you shall call them to mind לבב among all the nations where the LORD your God has driven you.

Deuteronomy 30:2 and shall return שוב to the LORD your God and shall obey His voice according to all that I command you today, you and your sons, with all your heart, and with all your soul,
Return to be right next to him.

Deuteronomy 30:3,4 Then the LORD your God will turn שוב your captivity. And He will have compassion on you, and will return שוב and gather you from all the nations where the LORD your God has scattered you. If you are driven out into the outermost parts of the heavens, the LORD your God will gather you from there, and He will bring you from there.

Deuteronomy 30:5 And the LORD your God will bring you into the land which your fathers possessed, and you shall possess it. And He will do you good, and multiply you above your fathers. And the LORD your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your seed, to love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, so that you may live.

Deuteronomy 30:6 And the LORD your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your seed, to love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, so that you may live.

Deuteronomy 32:28,29 For they are a nation void of counsel, neither is there any understanding in them. O that they were wise, that they understood this, that they would consider their latter end!

Haftarah

Isaiah 61:1,2 The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek, he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound, To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God.

Isaiah 61:4,5 And they shall build the old wastes, they shall raise up the former desolations, and they shall repair the waste cities, the desolations of

many generations. And strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, and the sons of the alien shall be your plowmen and your vinedressers.

Isaiah 61:8,9 For I the Lord love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering, and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them. And their seed shall be known among the Gentiles, and their offspring among the people: All that see them shall acknowledge them, that they are the seed which the Lord hath blessed.

Isaiah 62:10-12 Go through, Go through the gates! Prepare the way for the people, Build up, Build up the highway! Take out the stones, Lift up a banner for the peoples! Indeed the LORD has proclaimed to the end of the world: "Say to the daughter of Zion, 'Surely your **salvation**(Yeshua) **is coming**, **Behold, His reward is with Him, And His work before Him.**" And they shall call them The Holy People, The Redeemed of the LORD, And you shall be called Sought Out, A City Not Forsaken.

Revelation 22:12 And, behold, I come quickly, and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be. I am the Aleph and the Tav, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.

Isaiah 63:1-5 Who is this that cometh from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah? This that is glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save. Wherefore art thou red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat? I have trodden the winepress alone, and of the people there was none with me: For I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury, and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment. For the day of vengeance is in mine heart, and the year of my redeemed is come.

Psalm 47:1-3 O clap your hands, all ye people, shout unto God with the voice of triumph. For the Lord most high is terrible, he is a great King over all the earth. He subdues nations under us, and peoples under our feet.

Psalm 47:5-8 God has gone up with a shout, the Lord with the sound of a trumpet. Sing praises to God, sing praises! Sing praises to our King, sing praises! For God is the King of all the earth, sing praises with a psalm! God reigns over the nations, God sits on his holy throne.

Exodus 19:16 And it came to pass on the third day **in the morning**, that there were **thunders קולות** and lightnings, and a **thick cloud** upon the mount, **and the voice וקול of the shofar exceeding loud**, so that all the people that was in the camp trembled.

Revelation 1:10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a **great voice, as of a trumpet.**

Revelation 14:2 And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the **voice of a great thunder.**

Revelation 16:17,18 And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air, and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done. And there were **voices, and thunders, and lightnings, and there was a great earthquake,** such as was not since men were upon the earth, **so mighty an earthquake, and so great.**

Exodus 19:17,18 And Moses brought forth the people out of the camp to meet with God, and they stood at the nether part of the mount. And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because the Lord descended **upon it in fire:** and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, **and the whole mount quaked greatly.**

Revelations 4:1-5 After these things I saw, and behold, **a door opened in heaven,** and the first voice that I heard, a **voice as of a trumpet** speaking with me, one saying, Come up hither, and I will show thee the things which must come to pass hereafter. Straightway I was in the Spirit: And behold, there was **a throne set in heaven, and one sitting upon the throne,** and he that sat was to look upon like a jasper stone and a sardius: And there **was a rainbow round about the throne,** like an emerald to look upon. And round about **the throne** were **four and twenty thrones,** **and upon the thrones** I saw four and twenty elders sitting, arrayed in white garments, and on their heads crowns of gold. And **out of the throne proceed lightnings and voices and thunders.** And there was seven lamps of **fire burning before the throne,** which are the seven Spirits of God.

Revelation 5:1-5 And I saw in the right hand of him that sat **on the throne** a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals. And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy **to open the book,** and to loose the seals thereof? And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to **open the book,** neither to look thereon. And **I wept much,** because no man was found worthy **to open and to read the book,** neither to look thereon. And one of the elders saith unto me, **Weep not: Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book,** and to loose the seven seals thereof.

Decoding Zechariah

Zechariah 3:1 And he shewed me **Joshua the high priest** standing before the angel of the LORD, and Satan standing at his right hand to resist him.

Zechariah 4:1,2 And the angel that talked with me came again, and waked me, as a man that is wakened out of his sleep, And said unto me, What seest thou? And I said, I have looked, and behold **a candlestick all of gold**, with a bowl upon the top of it, and his seven lamps thereon, and **seven pipes to the seven lamps**, which are upon the top thereof.

Zechariah 4:3-5 And **two olive trees by it**, one upon the right side of the bowl, and the other upon the left side thereof. So I answered and spake to the angel that talked with me, saying, What are these, my lord? Then the angel that talked with me answered and said unto me, Knowest thou not what these be? And I said, No, my lord.

Zechariah 4:6 Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, **This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel**, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but **by My Spirit**, saith the LORD of hosts.

Isaiah 11:1,2 And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots: And **the spirit** of the LORD shall rest upon him, **the spirit** of wisdom and understanding, **the spirit** of counsel and might, **the spirit** of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.

Isaiah 60:1-4 Arise, shine, for **thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee**. For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: But **the LORD** shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be **seen upon thee**. And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising. Lift up thine eyes round about, and see: All they gather themselves together, they come to thee: Thy sons shall come from far, and thy daughters shall be nursed at thy side.

Isaiah 62:1,2 For Zion's sake will I not hold my peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until the righteousness thereof go forth **as brightness**, and the salvation thereof **as a lamp that burneth**. And the Gentiles shall see thy righteousness, and all kings thy glory: And **you shall be called** by a **new name, which the mouth of the LORD shall name**.

Revelation 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the assemblies, To him that overcomes will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone **a new name** written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.

Revelation 3:12 Him that overcomes will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: And I will write upon him the name of my God, and **the name** of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him **my new name**.

Zechariah 4:11-14 Then answered I, and said unto him, What are these **two olive trees upon the right side of the candlestick and upon the left side thereof**? And I answered again, and said unto him, What be these two olive branches which through the two golden pipes empty the golden oil out of themselves? And he answered me and said, Knowest thou not what these be? And I said, No, my lord. Then said he, These are the two anointed ones, that **stand by the Lord** of the whole earth.

Exodus 27:20,21 And thou shalt command the children of Israel, that **they bring thee pure oil olive beaten for the light, to cause the lamp to burn always**. In the tabernacle of the congregation without the vail, which is before the testimony, Aaron and his sons shall order it from **evening to morning** before the LORD: It shall be a statute forever unto their generations **on the behalf of the children of Israel**.

Exodus 19:6 And ye shall be unto me a **kingdom of priests, and an holy nation**. These are the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel.

Revelation 1:6 And hath made us **kings and priests** unto God and his Father, to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Zechariah 6:13 Even he shall build the temple of the LORD, and he shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon his throne, and he shall be **a priest upon his throne**.

Genesis 14:18,19 And Melchizedek, king of Salem, the priest of the Most High God, took bread and wine, And blessing him, said, May the blessing of the Most High God, maker of heaven and earth, be on Abram.

Revelation 1:20 The secret of the seven stars which you saw in my right hand, and of the seven gold vessels with burning lights. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: And the seven lights are the seven churches.

Matthew 5:14-16 You are the light of the world. A town put on a hill may be seen by all. And a burning light is not put under a vessel, but on its table, so that its rays may be shining on all who are in the house. Even so let your light

be shining before men, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven.

1 Peter 2:5 You, as living stones, are being made into a house of the spirit, a holy order of priests, making those offerings of the spirit which are pleasing to God through Yeshua HaMashiach.

Zechariah 2:1,2 I lifted up mine eyes again, and looked, and behold a man with a **measuring line** in his hand. Then said I, Whither goest thou? And he said unto me, To measure Jerusalem, to see what is the breadth thereof, and what is the length thereof.

Revelation 11:1-3 Then I was given a measuring rod like a staff, and I was told, Rise and measure the temple of God and the altar and those who worship there, but do not measure the court outside the temple; leave that out, for it is given over to the nations, and they will trample the holy city for **forty-two months**. And I will grant authority to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for **1,260 days**, clothed in sackcloth.

Zechariah 3:5 And I said, Let them set a fair mitre upon his head. So they set a fair mitre upon his head, and clothed him with garments. And the angel of the LORD stood by.

Revelation 7:20 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have **sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads**.

Then we have:

Zechariah 4:11 Then answered I, and said unto him, What are these two olive trees upon the right side of the candlestick and upon the left side thereof?

Revelation 11:4-6 These are the two olive trees, and the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth. And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: And if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed. These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: And have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

Revelation 11:7-9 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them. And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified. And they of the people and kindreds and

tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies three days and an half, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.

Revelation 11:19 And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: And there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.

Deuteronomy 32:32,33 For their vine is of the vine of Sodom, and of the fields of Gomorrah: their grapes are grapes of gall, their clusters are bitter: Their wine is the poison of dragons, and the cruel venom of asps.

Revelation 12:10-12 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: For the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony, and they loved not their lives unto the death. Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. **Woe to the inhabitants of the earth** and of the sea! For the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.

The Sixth Vision – Flying Scroll

Psalms 130:3,4 If thou, LORD, shouldest mark iniquities, O Lord, who shall stand? But there is forgiveness with thee, that thou mayest be feared.

Zechariah 5:1-3a Then I turned, and lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and behold a flying roll. And he said unto me, What seest thou? And I answered, I see a flying roll; the length thereof is **twenty cubits, and the breadth thereof ten cubits**. Then said he unto me,

1 Kings 6:3 And **the porch before the temple of the house, twenty cubits** was the length thereof, according to the breadth of the house; and **ten cubits** was the breadth thereof before the house.

1 Kings 7:7 Then he made a porch for the throne where he might judge, even **the porch of judgment**: And it was covered with cedar from one side of the floor to the other.

1 Samuel 2:3 Talk no more so exceeding proudly, let not arrogancy come out of your mouth: For the LORD is a God of knowledge, and **by him actions are weighed**.

Zechariah 5:3b This is the curse that goeth forth over the face of the whole earth. For everyone that stealeth shall be cut off as on this side according to it, and everyone that sweareth shall be cut off as on that side according to it.

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

Revelation 12:12-14 Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time. And when the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman which brought forth the man child. And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

Malachi 3:9,10 Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings. Ye are cursed with a curse: For ye have robbed me, even this whole nation. Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

Leviticus 6:1-5 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, If a soul sin, and commit a trespass against the LORD, and lie unto his neighbour in that which was delivered him to keep, or in fellowship, or in a thing taken away by violence, or hath deceived his neighbour, Or have found that which was lost, and lieth concerning it, and sweareth falsely, in any of all these that a man doeth, sinning therein: Then it shall be, because he hath sinned, and is guilty, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he hath deceitfully gotten, or that which was delivered him to keep, or the lost thing which he found, Or all that about which he hath sworn falsely, he shall even restore it in the principal, and shall add the fifth part more thereto, and give it unto him to whom it appertaineth, in the day of his trespass offering.

Numbers 30:2 When a man voweth a vow unto the LORD, or **swaereth an oath** to bind his soul with a bond, he shall not break his word, he shall do according to all that proceedeth out of his mouth.

Ezekiel 2:8-10 But thou, son of man, hear what I say unto thee, Be not thou rebellious like that rebellious house: Open thy mouth, and eat that I give thee. And when I looked, behold, an hand was sent unto me, and, lo, a roll of a book was therein, And he spread it before me, and it was written **within and without**: And there was written therein lamentations, and mourning, and woe.

Exodus 32:15 And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the two tables of the testimony were in his hand: The tables were written on both their sides, on the one side and on the other were they written.

Deuteronomy 27:26 Cursed is he who does not take this law to heart to do it. And let all the people say, So be it.

Deuteronomy 28:15 But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day, that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee.

Revelation 10:8-11 And the voice which I heard from heaven spake unto me again, and said, Go and take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel which standeth upon the sea and upon the earth. And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take it, and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey. And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: And as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter. And he said unto me, Thou must prophesy again before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings.

Zechariah 5:4 I will bring it forth, saith the LORD of hosts, and **it shall enter into the house of the thief, and into the house of him that swaereth falsely by my name: And it shall remain in the midst of his house, and shall consume it with the timber thereof and the stones thereof.**

Leviticus 14:45 And the house will have to be pulled down, the stones of it and the wood and the paste, and everything is to be taken out to an unclean place outside the town.

Revelation 22:15 Outside are the dogs, and those who make use of evil powers, those who make themselves unclean, and the takers of life, and those who give worship to images, and everyone whose **delight is in what is false**.

Isaiah 59:12-16 For our evil doings are increased before you, and our sins give witness against us: For our evil doings are with us, and we have knowledge of our sins: We have gone against the Lord, and been false to him, turning away from our God, our words have been uncontrolled, and in our hearts are thoughts of deceit. And the right is turned back, and righteousness is far away: For good faith is not to be seen in the public places, and upright behaviour may not come into the town. Yes, faith is gone, and he whose heart is turned from evil comes into the power of the cruel: And the Lord saw it, and he was angry that there was no one to take up their cause. And he saw that there was no man, and was surprised that there was no one to take up their cause: So his arm gave salvation, and he made righteousness his support.
