TORAH PORTION

Deuteronomy 26:1,2 And it shall be, when you come into the land **which the LORD your God gives you for an inheritance, and possess it**, and live in it, you shall take of the first of all the fruit of the earth which you shall bring of your land that **the LORD your God gives you**, and you shall put it in a basket, and shall go to the place which the LORD your God shall choose to place His name there.

Deuteronomy 26:3,4 And thou shalt go unto the priest that shall be in those days, and say unto him, I profess this day unto the LORD thy God, that I am come unto the country which the LORD swore unto our fathers for to give us. And the priest shall take the basket out of thine hand, and set it down before the altar of the LORD thy God.

Deuteronomy 26:10 And now, behold, I have brought the firstfruits ראשית of the land,

John 12:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a grain of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abides alone: But if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

1 Corinthians 15:20 But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the first fruits of them that slept.

Psalm 30:1 I will extol thee, O LORD, for thou hast lifted me up, and hast not made my foes to rejoice over me.

Psalm 30:3 O LORD, thou hast brought up my soul from the grave: Thou hast kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.

Deuteronomy 26:8-11 And the LORD brought us forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand, and with an outstretched arm, and with great terribleness, and with signs, and with wonders: And he hath brought us into this place, and hath given us this land, even a land that flows with milk and honey. And now, behold, I have brought the first fruits of the land, which thou, O LORD, hast given me. And thou shalt set it before the LORD thy God, and worship before the LORD thy God: And thou shalt rejoice in every good thing which the LORD thy God hath given unto thee, and unto thine house, thou, and the Levite, and the stranger that is among you.

Deuteronomy 26:16-19 Today the LORD your God has commanded you to do these statutes and judgments. You therefore shall keep and do them

with all your heart and with all your soul. You have **today** said that the LORD is our God, and that you would **walk in His ways**, and *keep His statutes and His commandments and His judgments, and listen* to His voice. And *the LORD has taken you **today** to be His peculiar people*, as He has promised you, and to *keep all His commandments*, and to make you high above all nations which he has made, in praise and in name and in honor, and that you may be a holy people to the LORD your God, even as He has spoken.

Deuteronomy 27:9,10 And Moses and the priests the Levites spoke to all Israel, saying: Take heed and listen, O Israel. **Today you have become the people of the LORD your God**. You shall therefore obey the voice of the LORD your God, and do His commandments and His statutes which I command you **today**.

Deuteronomy 28:1,2 And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth: And all these **blessings** shall come on thee, **and overtake thee**, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God.

Deuteronomy 28:8,9 The Lord shall **command the blessing** upon thee in thy storehouses, and in all that thou set thine hand unto, and he shall **bless** thee in the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee. The Lord shall establish thee an holy people unto himself, as he hath sworn unto thee, if thou shalt keep the commandments of the Lord thy God, and walk in his ways.

Deuteronomy 28:13 And the Lord shall **make thee the head, and not the tail**, And thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath, if that thou hearken unto the commandments of the Lord thy God, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do them.

Deuteronomy 28:15 But it shall come to pass, **if thou wilt not hearken** unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day, that **all these curses shall come upon thee**, and overtake thee.

Deuteronomy 28:45-47 All these curses shall come upon you and pursue you and overtake you till you are destroyed, because you did not obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep his commandments and his statutes that he commanded you. They shall be a sign and a wonder against you and your offspring forever. **Because you did not serve the LORD your**

God with joyfulness and gladness of heart, because of the abundance of all things.

Deuteronomy 27:25,26 Cursed be he that **taketh reward to slay an innocent person.** And all the people shall say, Amen. **Cursed be he that confirm not all the words of this law to do them. And all the people shall say, Amen.**

Galatians 3:10 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: For it is written, **Cursed is every one that continue not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.**

Deuteronomy 27:19-24 Cursed be he that pervert the judgment of the stranger, fatherless, and widow. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lieth with his father's wife because he uncover his father's skirt. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lieth with any manner of beast. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lie with his sister, the daughter of his father, or the daughter of his mother. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lie with his mother-in-law. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that smite his neighbor secretly. And all the people shall say, Amen.

Deuteronomy 29:19,20 And it come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, I shall have peace, though I walk in the imagination of mine heart, to add drunkenness to thirst: The Lord will not spare him, but then the anger of the Lord and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the Lord shall blot out his name from under heaven.

Galatians 3:11 But that **no man is justified by the law** in the sight of God, it is evident: For, **The just shall live by faith.**

Habakkuk 2:4 Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: But the just shall live by his faith.

Deuteronomy 28:29 And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind grope in darkness.

Matthew 27:45 Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour.

Amos 8:9,10 And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord GOD, that I will cause the sun to go down **at noon**, and **I will darken the earth in**

the clear day: And I will turn your feasts into mourning, and all your songs into lamentation, and I will bring up sackcloth upon all loins, and baldness upon every head, and I will make it as the mourning of an only son, and the end thereof as a bitter day.

Isaiah 60:1-3 Arise, shine, for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee. For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: But the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee. And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising.

Isaiah 60:5 Then thou shalt see, and flow together, and thine heart shall fear, and be enlarged, because the abundance of the sea shall be converted unto thee, the forces of the Gentiles shall come unto thee.

Isaiah 60:11,12 Therefore thy gates shall be open continually, they shall not be shut day nor night, that men may bring unto thee the forces of the Gentiles, and that their kings may be brought. For the nation and kingdom that will not serve thee shall perish, yea, those nations shall be utterly wasted.

Isaiah 60:14 The sons also of them that afflicted thee shall come bending unto thee, and all they that despised thee shall bow themselves down at the soles of thy feet, and they shall call thee, The city of the LORD, The Zion of the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 2:1-3 The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem. And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of the LORD'S house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills, and all nations shall flow unto it. And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob, and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: For out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

LETTERS FROM YOCHANAN Died in 99ad

John 19:26,27 When Yeshua saw his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to his mother, Woman, behold, your son! Then he said to the disciple, Behold, your mother! And from **that hour the disciple took her to his own home.**

Acts 12:1-3 About that time **Herod the king** laid violent hands on some who belonged to the church. He killed **James the brother of John** with the sword, and when he saw that **it pleased the Jews**, he proceeded to **arrest Peter** also. This was during the days of Unleavened Bread.

HHBNT Revelation 2:8-11 So then, also to the angel (**Messenger-Polycarp!**) appointed over the congregation in Smyrna write: The First and the Last, **the One who was dead and has returned to life** says this: I know your sufferings and your poverty, even if you are really rich, and also the blasphemy by those who claim that they are Jewish but are not, and so become a meeting place of Satan. **Do not fear what you are about to suffer.** See, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison so that you will be tried. For ten days you must endure tribulation. **Be faithful even if you have to die [for your faithfulness], and I will give to you the crown of life.** Let everyone who has ears to listen pay close attention to what the Spirit says to the congregations. **The one who overcomes will not be hurt in any way by the second death.**

1 John 1:1,2 That which was from the first, which has come to our ears, and which we have seen with our eyes, **looking on it and touching it with our hands, about the Word of life** (And the life was made clear to us, and we have seen it and are witnessing to it and giving you word of that **eternal life** which was with the Father and **was seen by us**).

John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

1 John 1:3,4 We give you word of all we have seen and everything which has come to our ears, so that you may be united with us, and we are united with the Father and with his Son Yeshua HaMashiach: And we are writing these things to you so that our joy may be made complete.

1 John 1:5,6 This is the word which came to us from him and which we give to you, that **God is light** and in him there is nothing dark. If we say we are joined to him, and are walking still in the dark, our words are false, and our acts are untrue.

1 John 1:7,8 But if we are walking in the light, as he is in the light, we are all united with one another, and the blood of Yeshua his Son makes us clean from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we are false to ourselves and there is nothing true in us.

1 John 1:9,10 If we say openly that we have done wrong, he is upright and true to his word, giving us forgiveness of sins and making us clean from all evil. If we say that we have no sin, we make him false, and his word is not in us.

1 John 2:1-3 My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may be without sin. And if any man is a sinner, we have a friend and helper with the Father, Yeshua HaMashiach, the upright one: He is the offering for our sins, and not for ours only, but for all the world. And by this we may be certain that we have knowledge of him if we keep his laws.

1 John 2:4-6 The man who says, **I have knowledge of him, and does not keep his laws**, is false, and there is nothing true in him: But in every man who keeps his word, the love of God is made complete. By this we may be certain that we are in him: He who says that he is living in him, **will do as he did**.

1 John 2:7,8 My loved ones, I do not give you a new law, but an old law which you had from the first, this old law is the word which came to your ears. Again, I give you a new law, which is true in him and in you, for the night is near its end and the true light is even now shining out.

1 John 2:9-11 He who says that he is in the light, and has hate in his heart for his brother, is still in the dark. He who has love for his brother is in the light, and there is no cause of error in him. But he who has hate for his brother is in the dark, walking in the dark with no knowledge of where he is going, unable to see because of the dark.

1 John 2:12-14 I am writing to you, **my children**, because you have forgiveness of sins through his name. I am writing to you, **fathers**, because you have knowledge of him who was from the first. I am writing to you, **young men**, because you have overcome the Evil One.

1 John 2:15-17 Have no love for the world or for the things which are in the world. If any man has love for the world, the love of the Father is not in him. Because everything in the world, the desire of the flesh, the desire of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father but of the world. And the world and its desires is coming to an end: But he who does God's pleasure is living forever.
