TORAH PORTION

Genesis 5:28,29 Lamech lived one hundred eighty-two years, and became the father of a son, and he named him **Noah**, saying, This same will **comfort** us in our work and in the toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD has cursed.

Genesis 6:6,7 And the LORD regretted that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him to his heart. So the LORD said, I will blot out man whom I have created from the face of the land, man and animals and creeping things and birds of the heavens, for I am sorry that I have made them.

Genesis 6:8 But **Noah found grace** in the eyes of the LORD.

Hebrews 11:7 By **faith** Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house, by the which he condemned the world, and **became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.**

Genesis 6:9 These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and **perfect** in his generations, and **Noah walked with God.**

Amos 3:3 Can two walk together, except they be agreed?

Deuteronomy 8:6 Therefore you shall keep the commandments of the LORD your God, to walk in his ways, and to fear him.

Genesis 6:22 Thus Noah did. According to all that God commanded him, so he did.

Genesis 7:16 Those who went in, went in male and female of all flesh, as God commanded him, and the **LORD shut him in.**

Luke 13:22-25 He went on his way through cities and villages, teaching, and traveling on to Jerusalem. One said to him, Lord, are they few who are saved? He said to them, Strive to enter in by the narrow door, for many, I tell you, will seek to enter in, and will not be able. When once the master of the house has risen up, and has **shut the door**, and you begin to stand outside, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open to us! Then he will answer and tell you, I don't know you or where you come from.

Genesis 6:17,18 And, behold, I, even I, do bring a flood of waters on the earth, to destroy all flesh, wherein is the breath of life, from under heaven, and everything that is in the earth shall die. But with you will I establish **my covenant**, and you shall come into the ark, you, and your sons, and your wife, and your sons' wives with you.

Genesis 7:4 For yet **seven days**, and I will cause it to rain upon the earth forty days and forty nights, and every living substance that I have made will I destroy from off the face of the earth.

Genesis 7:7-12 And Noah went in, and his sons, and his wife, and his sons' wives with him, into the ark, because of the waters of the flood. Of clean beasts, and of beasts that are not clean, and of fowls, and of everything that creeps upon the earth, there went in two and two unto Noah into the ark, the male and the female, as God had commanded Noah. And it came to pass after seven days, that the waters of the flood were upon the earth. In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.

Genesis 7:17 And the flood was forty days on the earth, and the waters increased, and bore up the ark, and it was lift up above the earth.

Genesis 8:3,4 And the waters returned from off the earth continually: And after the end of the hundred and fifty days the waters were abated. And the ark rested in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, on the mountains of Ararat.

Luke 17:26-30 As it happened in the days of Noah, even so will it be also in the days of the Son of Man. They ate, they drank, they married, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ship, and the flood came, and destroyed them all. Likewise, even as it happened **in the days of Lot**: They ate, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they built, but in the day that Lot went out from Sodom, it rained fire and sulfur from the sky, and destroyed them all. It will be the same way in the day that the Son of Man is revealed.

Genesis 8:5 And the waters decreased continually until the tenth month: In the tenth month, on the first day of the month, were the tops of the mountains seen.

Genesis 8:6-9 And it came to pass at **the end of forty days**, that Noah opened the window of the ark which he had made: And he sent forth a raven, which went forth to and fro, until the waters were dried up from off the earth. Also **he sent forth a dove** from him, to see if the waters were abated from off the face of the ground, But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters were on the face of the whole earth: Then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark.

Job 1:7 And the LORD said to Satan, From where come you? Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it.

Revelation 18:2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

Matthew 3:16 Yeshua, when he was immersed, went up directly from the water: And behold, the heavens were opened to him. He saw the Spirit of God descending as a dove, and coming on him.

Genesis 8:10,11 And he stayed yet other seven days, and again he sent forth the dove out of the ark, And the dove came in to him in the evening, and, see, in her mouth was an olive leaf plucked off: So Noah knew that the waters were abated from off the earth.

Romans 11:16-18 For if the first fruit be holy, the lump is also holy: And if the root be holy, so are the branches. And if some of the branches be broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, and with them partake of the root and fatness of the olive tree, Boast not against the branches. But if you boast, you bore not the root, but the root you.

Isaiah 11:1 And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots.

Revelation 22:2 In the middle of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bore twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: And the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.

Leviticus 4:16 And the priest that is anointed shall bring of the bullock's blood to the tabernacle of the congregation.

Genesis 8:12 And he stayed yet other seven days, and sent forth the dove, which returned not again to him any more.

Genesis 8:13 And it came to pass in the six hundredth and first year, in the first month, the first day of the month, the waters were dried up from off the earth: And Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and, behold, the face of the ground was dry.

Genesis 8:14-17 In the second month, on the twenty-seventh day of the month, the earth was dry. God spoke to Noah, saying, Go out of the ship, you, and your wife, and your sons, and your sons' wives with you. Bring out with you every living thing that is with you of all flesh, including birds, livestock, and every creeping thing that creeps on the earth, that they may breed abundantly in the earth, and be fruitful, and multiply on the earth.

Genesis 9:11-13 I will establish my covenant with you: All flesh will not be cut off any more by the waters of the flood, neither will there ever again be a flood to destroy the earth. God said, This is the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for perpetual generations: I set my rainbow in the cloud, and it will be for a sign of a covenant between me and the earth.

Genesis 9:19-21 These three were the sons of Noah, and of these was the whole earth overspread. And Noah the husbandman began, and planted a vineyard. And he drank of the wine, and was drunken, and he was uncovered within his tent.

Genesis 10:8-10a And Cush begat Nimrod: He began to be a mighty one in the earth. He was a mighty hunter before the LORD: Why it is said, Even as Nimrod the mighty hunter before the LORD. And the beginning of his kingdom was **Babel.**

Genesis 11:4 They said, Come, let's build ourselves a city, and a tower whose top reaches to the sky, and **let's make ourselves a name,** lest we be scattered abroad on the surface of the whole earth.

Isaiah 66:1,2 Thus said the LORD, The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool: Where is the house that you build to me? And where is the place of my rest? For all those things has my hand made, and all those things have been, said the LORD: But **to this man will I look,** even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembles at my word.

Isaiah 66:4,5 I also will choose their delusions, and will bring their fears on them, because **when I called, no one answered, when I spoke, they didn't listen,** but they did that which was evil in my eyes, and chose that in which I didn't delight. Hear the word of the LORD, you who tremble at his word: Your brothers who hate you, who cast you out for my name's sake, have said, Let the LORD be glorified, that we may see your joy; but it is those who shall be disappointed.

Isaiah 66:18,19 For I know their works and their thoughts: The time comes, that **I will gather all nations and languages, and they shall come, and shall see my glory. I will set a sign among them,** and I will send such as escape of them to the nations, to Tarshish, Pul, and Lud, who draw the bow, to Tubal and Javan, **to the islands afar off, who have not heard my fame, neither have seen my glory, and they shall declare my glory among the nations.**

Decoding Zechariah

Zechariah 8:6 Thus saith the LORD of hosts, If it be marvellous in the eyes of the remnant of this people in these days, should it also be marvellous in mine eyes? **Saith the LORD of hosts.**

Jeremiah 32:17-19 Ah Lord God! See, you have made the heaven and the earth by your great power and by your outstretched arm, and **there is nothing you are not able to do:** You have mercy on thousands, and send punishment for the evil-doing of the fathers on their children after them: The great, the strong God, the Lord of armies is his name: Great in wisdom and strong in act: Whose eyes are open on all the ways of the sons of men, **giving to everyone the reward of his ways and the fruit of his doings.**

Zechariah 8:7,8 Thus saith the LORD of hosts, Behold, I will save my people from the east country, and from the west country, And I will bring them, and they shall dwell **in the midst of Jerusalem:** And **they shall be my people, and I will be their God, in truth and in righteousness.**

Isaiah 43:5,6 Fear not: For I am with thee: I will bring thy seed **from the east, and gather thee from the west,** I will say to the north, Give up, and to the south, Keep not back: Bring my sons from far, and my daughters from the ends of the earth.

Psalms 50:1 The mighty God, even the LORD, hath spoken, and called the earth from the rising of the sun unto the going down thereof. Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God hath shined.

Jeremiah 32:38-41 And they shall be my people, and I will be their God: And I will give them one heart and one way, that they may fear Me forever, for the good of them, and of their children after them, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from them, to do them good, and I will put My fear in their hearts, that they shall not depart from Me. Yea, I will rejoice over them to do them good, and I will plant them in this land in truth with My whole heart and with My whole soul.

Zechariah 8:9 Thus saith the LORD of hosts, **Let your hands be strong,** ye that hear in these days, these words by the mouth of the prophets, which were in the day that the foundation of the house of the LORD of hosts was laid, **that the temple might be built.**

Haggai 2:4 **Yet now be strong,** O Zerubbabel, saith the LORD, and be strong, O Joshua, son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and be strong, all ye people of the land, saith the LORD, and work, for I am with you, saith the LORD of hosts.

Ezra 5:1,2 Now the prophets, Haggai the prophet, and Zechariah the son of Iddo, prophesied unto the Jews that were in Judah and Jerusalem, in the name of the God of Israel prophesied they unto them. Then rose up Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and began to build the house of God which is at Jerusalem, and with them were the prophets of God, helping them.

Zechariah 8:10,11 For **before these days there was no hire for man**, nor any hire for beast, neither was there any peace to him that went out or came in because of the affliction: For I set all men everyone against his neighbor. But now I will not be unto the residue of this people as in the former days, saith the LORD of hosts.

Haggai 1:5,6 Now therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts: Consider your ways. Ye have sown much, and brought in little, ye eat, but ye have not enough, ye drink, but ye are not filled with drink, ye clothe you, but there is none warm, and he that earneth wages earneth wages for a bag with holes.

Zechariah 8:12 For the seed shall be prosperous, the vine shall give her fruit, and the ground shall give her increase, and the heavens shall give their dew, and I will cause the remnant of this people to possess all these things.

Hosea 2:21-23 And it shall come to pass in that day, I will respond, saith the LORD, I will respond to the heavens, and they shall respond to the earth, And the earth shall respond to the corn, and the wine, and the oil, and they shall respond to Jezreel. (That is, Whom God soweth.) And I will sow her unto Me in the land, and I will have compassion upon her that had not obtained compassion, and I will say to them that were not My people: Thou art My people, and they shall say: Thou art my God.

Zechariah 8:13 And it shall come to pass, that as ye were a curse among the heathen, O house of Judah, and house of Israel, **so will I save you, and ye shall be a blessing**: Fear not, but **let your hands be strong**.

Zechariah 8:14,15 For thus saith the LORD of hosts, As I thought to punish you, when your fathers provoked me to wrath, saith the LORD of hosts, and I repented not: So again have I thought in these days to do well unto Jerusalem and to the house of Judah: Fear ye not.

Jeremiah 32:42 For thus saith the LORD: Like as I have brought all this great evil upon this people, so will I bring upon them all the good that I have promised them.

Zechariah 8:16,17 These are the things that ye shall do, Speak ye every man the truth to his neighbor, execute the judgment of truth and peace in your gates: And

let none of you imagine evil in your hearts against his neighbor, and love no false oath: For all these are things that **I hate**, saith the LORD.

Zechariah 8:18,19 And the word of the LORD of hosts came unto me, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, The fast of the fourth month, and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful feasts, therefore love the truth and peace.

Zechariah 8:20,21 Thus saith the LORD of hosts, It shall yet come to pass, that there shall come people, and the inhabitants of many cities: And the inhabitants of one city shall go to another, saying, Let us go speedily to pray before the LORD, and to seek the LORD of hosts: I will go also.

Isaiah 2:2,3 And it shall come to pass in the end of days, that the mountain of the LORD'S house shall be established as the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills, and all nations shall flow unto it. And many peoples shall go and say: **Come ye, and let us** go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob, and He will teach us of His ways, and we will walk in His paths. For out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

Isaiah 11:9 They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain, for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.

Numbers 14:21 But in very deed, as I live--and all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the LORD.

Zechariah 8:22,23 Yea, many people and strong nations shall come to seek the LORD of hosts in Jerusalem, and to pray before the LORD. Thus saith the LORD of hosts, In those days it shall come to pass, that ten men shall take hold out of all languages of the nations, even shall take hold of the skirt of him that is a Jew, saying, We will go with you: For we have heard that God is with you.

Isaiah 66:18 For I [know] their works and their thoughts, [the time] cometh, that I will gather all nations and tongues, and they shall come, and shall see My glory.

Ruth 1:16 But Ruth said, Give up requesting me to go away from you, or to go back without you: For where you go I will go, and where you take your rest I will take my rest, your people will be my people, and your God my God.

Zechariah 9:1 The burden of the word of the LORD in the land of Hadrach, and **Damascus** shall be the rest thereof: **When the eyes of man, as of all the tribes of Israel, shall be toward the LORD.**

Isaiah 17:1 The burden of Damascus. Behold, Damascus is taken away from being a city, and it shall be a ruinous heap.

Isaiah 17:4-7 And in that day it shall come to pass, that the glory of Jacob shall be made thin, and the fatness of his flesh shall wax lean. And it shall be as when the harvestman gathereth the corn, and reapeth the ears with his arm, and it shall be as he that gathereth ears in the valley of Rephaim. Yet gleaning grapes shall be left in it, as the shaking of an olive tree, two or three berries in the top of the uppermost bough, four or five in the outmost fruitful branches thereof, saith the LORD God of Israel. **At that day shall a man look to his Maker, and his eyes shall have respect to the Holy One of Israel.**

Isaiah 26:8-11 We have been waiting for you, O Lord, the desire of our soul is for the memory of your name. In the night the desire of my soul has been for you, early will my spirit be searching for you, for **when your punishments come on the earth, the people of the world will get the knowledge of righteousness.** Even if you are kind to the evil-doer, he will not go after righteousness, even in the land of the upright he will still go on in his wrongdoing, and will not see the glory of the Lord. Lord, your hand is lifted up, but they do not see: Let them see yes, your haters will be burned up in the fire.

Zechariah 9:2-4 And **Hamath also** shall border thereby, **Tyrus, and Zidon**, though it be very wise. And Tyrus did build herself a strong hold, and heaped up silver as the dust, and fine gold as the mire of the streets. Behold, the Lord will cast her out, and he will smite her power in the sea, and she shall be devoured with fire.

Zechariah 9:5-7 Ashkelon shall see it, and fear, Gaza also shall see it, and be very sorrowful, and Ekron, for her expectation shall be ashamed, and the king shall perish from Gaza, and Ashkelon shall not be inhabited. And a bastard shall dwell in Ashdod, and I will **cut off the pride of the Philistines.** And I will take away his blood out of his mouth, and his abominations from between his teeth: But he that remaineth, even he, shall be for our God, and he shall be as a governor in Judah, and Ekron as a Jebusite.

2 Samuel 24:18-25 And Gad came that day to David, and said unto him, Go up, rear an altar unto the LORD in the threshingfloor of Araunah the Jebusite. And David, according to the saying of Gad, went up as the LORD commanded. And Araunah looked, and saw the king and his servants coming on toward him: And Araunah went out, and bowed himself before the king on his face upon the ground. And Araunah said, Wherefore is my lord the king come to his servant? And David said, To buy the threshingfloor of thee, to build an altar unto the

LORD, that the plague may be stayed from the people. And Araunah said unto David, Let my lord the king take and offer up what seemeth good unto his.

Behold, **here be oxen for burnt sacrifice, and threshing instruments and other instruments of the oxen for wood.** All these things did Araunah, as a king, give unto the king. And Araunah said unto the king, The LORD thy God accept thee. And the king said unto Araunah, Nay, but I will surely buy it of thee at a price: Neither will I offer burnt offerings unto the LORD my God of that which doth cost me nothing. So David bought the threshingfloor and the oxen for fifty shekels of silver. And David built there an altar unto the LORD, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD was intreated for the land, and the plague was stayed from Israel.

Zechariah 9:8 And I will encamp about mine house because of the army, because of him that passeth by, and because of him that returneth: And no oppressor shall pass through them anymore: For **now have I seen with mine eyes.**

Exodus 3:7 And God said, Truly, I have seen the grief of my people in Egypt, and their cry because of their cruel masters has come to my ears, for I have knowledge of their sorrows.
