## TORAH PORTION

**Genesis 28:1-5** And Isaac called Jacob, and blessed him, and charged him, and said unto him, You shalt not take a wife of the daughters of Canaan.

**Genesis 28:10,11** And Jacob went out from Beersheba, and went toward Haran. And he **lighted** (came to) on **a certain place**, and tarried there all night, because the **sun was set**, and he took of the stones of that place, and put them for his pillows, and lay down in **that place** to sleep.

**Genesis 28:12,13** And he dreamed, and beheld a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven: And behold *the angels of God ascending and descending on it*. And, behold, **the LORD stood above it(HIM)**, and said, **I am the LORD God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac**: The land where on thou lie, to you will I give it, and to your seed.

**Genesis 28:15** And, behold, I am with you, and will keep you in all places where you go, and will bring you again into this land, for I will not leave you, until I have done that which I have spoken to you of.

**Genesis 28:17-19a** And he was afraid, and said, How dreadful is **this place!** This is none other but the **house of God**, and **this is the gate of heaven**. And Jacob rose up early in the morning, and took **the stone** that he had put for his pillows, and set it up for a pillar, and poured oil upon the top of it. And he called the name of **that place Bethel**.

**John 1:47-49** Yeshua saw Nathanael coming toward Him, and said of him, Behold, an Israelite indeed, in whom is no deceit! Nathanael said to Him, How do You know me? Yeshua answered and said to him, Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you. Nathanael answered and said to Him, Rabbi, You are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!

**John 1:51** And he said to him, Truly, truly, I say to you, Hereafter you shall see heaven open, and **the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of man**.

**John 3:13** And no man has ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven.

**John 18:4-6** Yeshua therefore, knowing all the things that were coming upon him, went forth, and said to them, Whom are you seeking? They answered him, Yeshua of Nazareth. Yeshua said unto them, **I am He**. And Judas also, who betrayed him, was standing with them. When therefore he said to them, **I am He**, they went backward, and fell to the ground.

**Isaiah 48:12** Harken unto **Me**, O Jacob, and Israel My called: **I am He**, *I am the first, I also am the last*. Yea, **My hand** hath laid the foundation of the earth, and **My right hand** hath spread out the heavens, when I call out to them, they stand up together.

**Isaiah 48:16** Come near to **Me**, hear this: I have not spoken in secret *from the beginning*, From the time that it was, **I** was there. **And** now **the Lord God and His Spirit** have sent **Me**.

**Genesis 28:20-22** And Jacob vowed a vow, saying, If God will be with me, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat, and raiment to put on, So that I come again to my father's house in peace, then shall the LORD be my God: And this stone, which I have set for a pillar, shall be God's house: And of all that you shall give me I will surely give the tenth to you.

**Genesis 29:1** Then Jacob went on his journey, and came into the land of the people of the east.

**Genesis 29:1** And Jacob lifted up his feet, and went towards the land of the sons of the east.

**Genesis 29:2,3** And he looked, and behold a well in the field, and, see, there were three flocks of sheep lying by it, for out of that well they watered the flocks: And a great stone was on the well's mouth. And thither were all the flocks gathered: And they rolled the stone from the well's mouth, and watered the sheep, and put the stone again on the **well's mouth** in his place.

**Genesis 29:7-9** And he said, See, it is yet high day, neither is it time that the cattle should be gathered together: Water you the sheep, and go and feed them. And they said, We cannot, until all the flocks be gathered together, and till they roll the stone from the **well's mouth**, then we water the sheep. And while he yet spoke with them, Rachel came with her father's sheep, for she kept them.

**Genesis 29:10** And it came to pass, when Jacob saw Rachel the daughter of Laban his mother's brother, and the sheep of Laban his mother's brother, that Jacob went near, and rolled the stone from the well's mouth, and watered the flock of Laban his mother's brother.

**Mark 16:1-4** And when the sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him. And very early in the morning the first day of the week, they came to the sepulcher at the rising of the sun. And they said among themselves, Who shall roll us away the stone from the door of the sepulcher? And when they looked, they saw that the stone was rolled away: For it was very great.

**Genesis 29:12,13a** And Jacob told Rachel that he was her father's brother, and that he was Rebekah's son: And she ran and told her father. And it came to pass, when Laban heard the tidings of Jacob his sister's son, that he ran to meet him, and embraced him, and kissed him, and brought him to his house.

**Genesis 29:18-20** And Jacob loved Rachel, and said, I will serve thee seven years for Rachel thy younger daughter. And Laban said, It is better that I give her to thee, than that I should give her to another man: Abide with me. And Jacob served seven years for Rachel, and they seemed unto him but a few days, for the love he had to her.

**Genesis 29:22,23** And Laban gathered together all the men of the place, and made a **feast**. And it came to pass in the evening, that he took Leah his daughter, and brought her to him, and he went in unto her.

**Genesis 29:24-26** And Laban gave to his daughter Leah Zilpah his maid for an handmaid. And it came to pass, that in the morning, behold, it was Leah: And he said to Laban, What is this you have done to me? Did not I serve with you for Rachel? Why then have you beguiled me? And Laban said, It must not be so done in our country, to give the younger before the firstborn.

**Genesis 29:27,28** Fulfil the week of this one, and we will give thee the other also for the service which thou shalt serve with me yet seven other years. And Jacob did so, and fulfilled her week, and he gave him Rachel his daughter to wife.

**Genesis 29:32** And Leah conceived, and bore a son, and she called his name Reuben: For she said, Surely the LORD has looked on my affliction, now therefore my husband will love me.

**Genesis 30:1,2** And when Rachel saw that she bore Jacob no children, Rachel envied her sister, and said to Jacob, Give me children, or else I die. And Jacob's anger was kindled against Rachel: And he said, Am I in God's stead, who has withheld from you the fruit of the womb?

**Genesis 30:22** And God remembered Rachel, and God listened to her, and **opened her womb**.

**Genesis 30:23,24** And she conceived, and bare a son, and said, God hath taken away my reproach: And she called his name Joseph, and said, The Lord shall **add** to me another son.

**Genesis 31:3** And the Lord said unto Jacob, Return unto the land of thy fathers, and to thy kindred, and I will be with thee.

**Genesis 31:41** These **twenty years** I have been in your house, I was your servant for fourteen years because of your daughters, and for six years I kept your flock, and ten times was my payment changed.

**Hosea 13:14** I will ransom them from the power of the grave, I will redeem them from death: O death, I will be thy plagues, O grave, I will be thy destruction: Repentance shall be hid from mine eyes.

**Hosea 14:5** I will be like the dew to Israel, he shall blossom like the lily, he shall take root like the trees of Lebanon.

**Hosea 14:9** Who is wise, and he shall understand these things? Prudent, and he shall know them? For the ways of the Lord are right, and the just shall walk in them: But the transgressors shall fall therein.

## Decoding Zechariah

**Zechariah 10:9,10** Though I scattered them **among the nations**, yet in far countries **they shall remember me**, and with their children they shall live and return. I will bring them home from the land of Egypt, and gather them from Assyria, and I will bring them to the land of Gilead and to Lebanon, till **there is no room for them**.

**Ezekiel 6:8-10** Yet will I leave a remnant, in that ye shall have some that escape the sword among the nations, when ye shall be scattered through the countries. And they that escape of **you shall remember Me among the nations** whither they shall be carried captives, how that I have been anguished with their straying heart, which hath departed from Me, and with their eyes, which are gone astray after their idols, and they shall loathe themselves in their own sight for the evils which they have committed in all their abominations. And they shall know that I am the LORD, I have not said in vain that I would do this evil unto them.

**Isaiah 11:11-13** And it shall come to pass in that day, that the Lord will set His hand again the second time to recover the remnant of His people, that shall remain from Assyria, and from Egypt, and from Pathros, and from Cush, and from Elam, and from Shinar, and from Hamath, and from the islands of the sea. **And He will set up an ensign for the nations, and will assemble the dispersed of Israel, and gather together the scattered of Judah from the four corners of the earth.** The envy also of Ephraim shall depart, and they that harass Judah shall be cut off, Ephraim shall not envy Judah, and Judah shall not vex Ephraim.

**Isaiah 49:20-22** The children of thy bereavement shall yet say in thine ears: The place is too strait for me, give place to me that I may dwell. Then shalt thou say in thy heart: Who hath begotten me these, seeing I have been bereaved of my children, and am solitary, an exile, and wandering to and fro? And who hath brought up these?

Behold, I was left alone, these, where were they? Thus saith the Lord GOD: Behold, **I will lift up My hand to the nations, and set up Mine ensign to the peoples, and they shall bring thy sons in their bosom, and thy daughters shall be carried upon their shoulders.**

**Zechariah 10:11,12** And over the sea affliction shall pass, and the waves shall be smitten in the sea, and all the depths of the Nile shall dry up, and the pride of Assyria shall be brought down, and the sceptre of Egypt shall depart away. And I will strengthen them in the LORD, and they shall walk up and down in His name, saith the LORD.

**1 Kings 7:2a** For he built **the house of the forest of Lebanon.**

**Zechariah 11:1,2** Open thy doors, O Lebanon, that the fire may devour thy cedars. Howl, fir tree, for the cedar is fallen, because the mighty are spoiled: Howl, O ye oaks of Bashan, for the forest of the vintage is come down.

**Zechariah 11:3-5** There is a voice of the howling of the shepherds, for their glory is spoiled: **A voice of the roaring of young lions,** for the pride of Jordan is spoiled. Thus saith the LORD my God, Feed **the flock of the slaughter.** Whose possessors (buyers) slay them, and hold themselves not guilty: And they that sell them say, Blessed be the LORD, for I am rich: And their own shepherds pity them not.

**Jeremiah 50:17,18** Israel is a scattered sheep, **the lions have driven him away,** first the king of **Assyria** hath devoured him, and last this Nebuchadnezzar king of **Babylon** hath broken his bones. Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Behold, I will punish the king of Babylon and his land, as I have punished the king of Assyria.

**Jeremiah 30:16,17** Therefore all they that devour thee shall be devoured, and all thine adversaries, every one of them, shall go into captivity, and they that spoil thee shall be a spoil, and all that prey upon thee will I give for a prey. For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the LORD, because they have called thee an outcast: She is Zion, there is none that careth for her.

**Zechariah 11:6** For I will no more pity the inhabitants of the land, saith the LORD: But, lo, I will deliver the men everyone into his neighbor's hand, and **into the hand of his king:** And they shall smite the land, and out of their hand I will not deliver them.

**John 19:15** But they cried out, Away with him, away with him, crucify him. Pilate saith unto them, Shall I crucify your King? The chief priests answered, We have no king but Caesar.

**John 11:48** If we let him thus alone, all men will believe on him: And the Romans shall come and take away both our place and nation.

**Zechariah 11:7** And I will feed the flock of slaughter, even you, O **poor of the flock**. And I took unto me **two staves**, the one I called **Beauty**, and the other I called **Bands**, and I fed the flock.

**John 10:11** I am the good shepherd: The good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

**Psalm 23:4** Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: For thou art with me, **thy rod and thy staff** they comfort me.

**Zechariah 11:8,9** **Three shepherds** also I cut off in one month, and my soul loathed them, and **their soul also abhorred me**. Then said I, I will not feed you: That that dieth, let it die, and that that is to be cut off, let it be cut off, and let the rest eat everyone the flesh of another.

**Matthew 26:3** Then assembled together the **chief priests, and the scribes, and the elders** of the people, unto the palace of the high priest, who was called Caiaphas.

**John 15:25** But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated me without a cause.

**Zechariah 11:10,11** And I **took my staff, even Beauty**, and cut it asunder, that I might break my covenant which I had made with all the people. And it was broken in that day: And **so the poor of the flock that waited upon me knew that it was the word of the LORD**.

**Jeremiah 1:11,12** Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Jeremiah, what seest thou? And I said, I see a rod of an almond tree. Then said the LORD unto me, Thou hast well seen: For I will hasten my word to perform it.

**Zechariah 11:12,13** And I said unto them, If ye think good, give me my price, and if not, forbear. So they weighed for my price **thirty pieces of silver**. And the LORD said unto me, Cast it unto the potter: A goodly price that I was prized at of them. And I took the thirty pieces of silver, and **cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD**.

**Exodus 21:32** If the ox shall push a manservant or a maidservant, he shall give unto their master **thirty shekels of silver**, and the ox shall be stoned.

**Zechariah 14:20,21** In that day shall there be upon the bells of the horses, **HOLINESS UNTO THE LORD**, and **the pots in the LORD's house** shall be like

the bowls before the altar. Yea, every pot in Jerusalem and in Judah shall be holiness unto the LORD of hosts.

**Matthew 27:3-10** Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. And they said, What is that to us? See thou to that. And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself. And the chief priests took the silver pieces, and said, It is not lawful for to put them into the treasury, because it is the price of blood. And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in. Wherefore that field was called, The field of blood, unto this day. Then was fulfilled that which was spoken **by Jeremiah the prophet**, saying, And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the price of him that was valued, whom they of the children of Israel did value, And gave them for the potter's field, as the Lord appointed me.

**Jeremiah 18:6-10** O house of Israel, cannot I do with you as this potter? Saith the LORD. Behold, as the clay is in the potter's hand, so are ye in mine hand, O house of Israel. At what instant I shall speak concerning a nation, and concerning a kingdom, to pluck up, and to pull down, and to destroy it, If that nation, against whom I have pronounced, turn from their evil, I will repent of the evil that I thought to do unto them. And at what instant I shall speak concerning a nation, and concerning a kingdom, to build and to plant it, If it do evil in my sight, that it obey not my voice, then I will repent of the good, wherewith I said I would benefit them.

**Jeremiah 19:1-3** Thus saith the LORD, Go and get a potter's earthen bottle, and take of the ancients of the people, and of the ancients of the priests, And go forth unto the valley of the son of Hinnom, which is by the entry of the east gate, and proclaim there the words that I shall tell thee, And say, Hear ye the word of the LORD, O kings of Judah, and inhabitants of Jerusalem, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, the which whosoever heareth, his ears shall tingle.

**Jeremiah 19:6-8** Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that this place shall no more be called Tophet, nor The valley of the son of Hinnom, but The valley of slaughter. And I will make void the counsel of Judah and Jerusalem in this place, and I will cause them to fall by the sword before their enemies, and by the hands of them that seek their lives: And their carcasses will I give to be meat for the fowls of the heaven, and for the beasts of the earth. And I will make this city desolate, and an hissing, every one that passeth thereby shall be astonished and hiss because of all the plagues thereof.

**Zechariah 11:14** Then I cut asunder **mine other staff, even Bands**, that I might break the brotherhood between Judah and Israel.

**Zechariah 11:15,16** And the LORD said unto me, Take unto thee yet the instruments of a **foolish shepherd**. For, lo, I will raise up a shepherd in the land, which shall not visit those that be cut off, neither shall seek the young one, nor heal that that is broken, nor feed that that standeth still: But he shall eat the flesh of the fat, and tear their claws in pieces.

**Zechariah 11:17** Woe to the **idol shepherd** that leaveth the flock! The sword shall be upon his arm, and upon his right eye: His arm shall be clean dried up, and his right eye shall be utterly darkened.
