TORAH PORTION

Genesis 17:17 Then Abraham fell upon his face, and **laughed**, and said in his heart, shall a child be born unto him that is a **hundred years old**? And shall Sarah, that is **ninety years old**, bear?

Genesis 21:1-3 And the LORD remembered Sarah as He had said, and the LORD did unto Sarah as He had spoken. And Sarah conceived, and bore Abraham a son in his old age, at the set time of which God had spoken to him. And Abraham called the name of his son that was born unto him, whom Sarah bore to him, **Isaac**.

Genesis 21:4-6 And Abraham circumcised his son Isaac when he was eight days old, as God had commanded him. And **Abraham was a hundred years old**, when his son Isaac was born unto him. And Sarah said: God hath made **laughter** for me; everyone that heareth will laugh on account of me.

Genesis 21:22-24 And it came to pass at that time, that Abimelech and Phicol the captain of his host spoke unto Abraham, saying: God is with thee in all that thou doest. Now therefore swear unto me here by God that thou wilt not deal falsely with me, nor with my son, nor with my son's son; but according to the kindness that I have done unto thee, thou shalt do unto me, and to the land wherein thou hast sojourned. And Abraham said: I will swear.

Numbers 29:1 And in the seventh month, on the first day of the month, ye shall have a holy convocation: ye shall do no manner of servile work; it is a day of blowing the horn unto you.

1 Samuel 1:11-13 And she vowed a vow, and said: O LORD of hosts, if Thou wilt indeed look on the affliction of Thy handmaid, and remember me, and not forget Thy handmaid, but wilt give unto Thy handmaid a man-child, then I will give him unto the LORD all the days of his life, and there shall no razor come upon his head. And it came to pass, as she prayed long before the LORD, that Eli watched her mouth. Now Hannah, she spoke in her heart; only her lips moved, but her voice could not be heard; therefore, Eli thought she had been drunken.

1 Samuel 1:14-17 And Eli said unto her: How long wilt thou be drunken? Put away thy wine from thee.' And Hannah answered and said: No, my lord, I am a woman of a sorrowful spirit; I have drunk neither wine nor strong drink, but I poured out my soul before the LORD. Count not thy handmaid for a wicked woman: for out of the abundance of my complaint and my vexation have I spoken hitherto. Then Eli answered and said: Go in peace, and the God of Israel grant thy petition that thou hast asked of Him.

1 Samuel 1:26-28 And she said: Oh, my lord, as thy soul liveth, my lord, I am the woman that stood by thee here, praying unto the LORD. For this child I prayed; and the LORD hath granted me my petition which I asked of Him; therefore I also have lent him to the LORD; as long as he liveth he is lent to the LORD. And he worshipped the LORD there.

1 Samuel 2:1 And Hannah prayed, and said: my heart exulteth in the LORD, my horn is exalted in the LORD; my mouth is enlarged over mine enemies; because I rejoice in Thy salvation.

Jeremiah 3:3-5 From afar the LORD appeared unto me. Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love; therefore with affection have I drawn thee. Again will I build thee, and thou shalt be built, O virgin of Israel; again shalt thou be adorned with thy tabrets, and shalt go forth in the dances of them that make merry. Again shalt thou plant vineyards upon the mountains of Samaria; the planters shall plant, and shall have the use thereof.

Jeremiah 31:6,7 For there shall be a day, that the watchmen shall call upon the mount Ephraim: arise ye, and let us go up to Zion, unto the LORD our God. For thus saith the LORD: Sing with gladness for Jacob, and shout at the head of the nations; announce ye, praise ye, and say: O LORD, save Thy people, The remnant of Israel.

Jeremiah 31:13 Then shall the virgin rejoice in the dance, and the young men and the old together; for I will turn their mourning into joy, and will comfort them, and make them rejoice from their sorrow.

Jeremiah 31:31-33 See, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new agreement with the people of Israel and with the people of Judah: Not like the agreement which I made with their fathers, on the day when I took them by the hand to be their guide out of the land of Egypt; which agreement was broken by them, and I gave them up, says the Lord. But this is the agreement which I will make with the people of Israel after those days, says the Lord; I will put my law in their inner parts, writing it in their hearts; and I will be their God, and they will be my people.

Genesis 41:1 And it came to pass **at the end** of two full years, that Pharaoh dreamed: and, behold, he stood by the river.

Genesis 41:29,30 Behold, there come **seven years** of great plenty throughout all the land of Egypt: And there shall arise after them **seven years** of famine; and all the plenty shall be forgotten in the land of Egypt; and the famine shall consume the land;

Deuteronomy 31:10-12 And Moses commanded them, saying, **At the end of every seven years, in the solemnity of the year of release, in the feast of tabernacles**, When all Israel is come to appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose, thou shalt read this law before all Israel in their hearing. Gather the people together, men, and women, and children, and thy stranger that is within thy gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear the LORD your God, and observe to do all the words of this law:

Luke 4:16,17 And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read. And there was delivered unto him the book of the prophet Isaiah And when he had opened the book, he found the place where it was written:

Luke 4:18,19 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, **to set at liberty** them that are bruised, **To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.**

Jeremiah 34:8-11 The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, after King Zedekiah had made a covenant with all the people in Jerusalem **to make a proclamation of liberty to them**, that everyone should set free his Hebrew slaves, male and female, so that no one should enslave a Jew, his brother. And they obeyed, all the officials and all the people who had entered into the covenant that everyone would set free his slave, male or female, so that they would not be enslaved again. They obeyed and set them free. **But afterward they turned around and took back the male and female slaves they had set free, and brought them into subjection as slaves.**

Jeremiah 34:15-17 You recently repented and did what was right in my eyes by proclaiming liberty, each to his neighbor, and you made a covenant before me in the house that is called by my name, but then you turned around and profaned my name when each of you took back his male and female slaves, whom you had set free according to their desire, and you brought them into subjection to be your slaves. Therefore, thus says the LORD: You have not obeyed me by proclaiming liberty, everyone to his brother and to his neighbor; behold, **I proclaim to you liberty to the sword, to pestilence, and to famine, declares the LORD.** I will make you a horror to all the kingdoms of the earth.

Daniel 9:2 In the first year of his reign I Daniel understood by books the number of the years, whereof the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah the prophet, that he would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem.

Daniel 9:24 **Seventy weeks** are decreed upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sin, and to forgive iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal vision and prophet, and to anoint the most holy place.

Daniel 9:27 And he shall confirm the covenant with many for **one week**: and in the **midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease**, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

Revelation 11:1-3 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein. But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months. And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall **prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth**.

Revelation 11:7-10 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them. And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified. And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies three days and an half, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves. And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these **two prophets tormented** them that dwelt on the earth.

Revelation 12:6 And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a **thousand two hundred and threescore days**.

Revelation 12:14 And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

Revelation 12:15-17 And the serpent **cast out of his mouth** water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood. And the earth helped the woman, and the earth **opened her mouth**, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon **cast out of his mouth**. And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of **her seed**, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Yeshua HaMashiach.

DECODING EZEKIEL

Ezekiel 13:1-4 The word of the LORD came to me: Son of man, prophesy **against the prophets** of Israel, who are prophesying, and say to those who prophesy from their own hearts: 'Hear the word of the LORD! Thus says the Lord GOD, Woe to the foolish prophets who follow their own spirit, and have seen nothing! Your prophets have been like jackals among ruins, O Israel.

Ezekiel 13:6-8 They have seen false visions and lying divinations. They say, **Declares the LORD**, when the LORD has not sent them, and yet **they expect him to fulfill their word**. Have you not seen a false vision and uttered a lying divination, whenever you have said, 'Declares the LORD, although I have not spoken? Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: Because you have uttered falsehood and seen lying visions, therefore behold, I am against you, declares the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 13:9 My hand will be against the prophets who see false visions and who give lying divinations. They shall not be in the council of my people, nor be enrolled in the register of the house of Israel, nor shall they enter the land of Israel. And you shall know that I am the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 13:22,23 Because with your false words you have given pain to the heart of the upright man when I had not made him sad; in order to make strong the hands of the evil-doer so that he may not be turned from his evil way and get life: For this cause you will see no more foolish visions or make false use of secret arts: and **I will make my people free from your power**; and you will be certain that I am the Lord.

Ezekiel 14:1-4 Then certain of the responsible men of Israel came to me and took their seats before me. And the word of the Lord came to me, saying, Son of man, **these men have taken their false gods into their hearts and put before their faces the sin which is the cause of their fall**: am I to give ear when they come to me for directions? For this cause say to them, These are the words of the Lord: Every man of Israel who has taken his false god into his heart, and put before his face the sin which is the cause of his fall, and comes to the prophet; I the Lord will give him an answer by myself in agreement with the number of his false gods;

Ezekiel 14:7,8 When any one of the men of Israel, or of those from other lands who are living in Israel, **who has become strange to me**, and takes his false gods into his heart, and puts before his face the sin which is the cause of his fall, comes to the prophet to get directions from me; I the Lord will give him an answer by

myself: And my face will be turned against that man, and I will make him a sign and a common saying, cutting him off from among my people; and you will be certain that I am the Lord.

Ezekiel 14:12-16 And the word of the Lord came to me, saying, Son of man, when a land, sinning against me, does wrong, and my hand is stretched out against it, and the **support of its bread** is broken, and I make it short of food, cutting off man and beast from it: Even if these three men, Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, only themselves would they keep safe by their righteousness, says the Lord. Or if **I send evil beasts** through the land causing destruction and making it waste, so that no man may go through because of the beasts: Even if these three men were in it, by my life, says the Lord, they would not keep safe their sons or daughters, but only themselves, and the land would be made waste.

Ezekiel 14:17-20 Or if **I send a sword** against that land, and say, Sword, go through the land, cutting off from it man and beast: Even if these three men were in it, by my life, says the Lord, they would not keep safe their sons or daughters, but only themselves. Or if **I send disease** into that land, letting loose my wrath on it in blood, cutting off from it man and beast: Even if Noah, Daniel, and Job were in it, by my life, says the Lord, they would not keep son or daughter safe; only themselves would they keep safe through their righteousness.

Ezekiel 14:21-23 For this is what the Lord has said: How much more when I send **my four bitter punishments** on Jerusalem, **the sword and need of food and evil beasts and disease**, cutting off from it man and beast? But truly, **there will still be a small band who will be safe, even sons and daughters**: and they will come out to you, and you will see their ways and their doings: and you will be comforted about the evil which I have sent on Jerusalem, even about everything I have sent on it. They will give you comfort when you see their ways and their doings: and you will be certain that not for nothing have I done all the things I have done in it, says the Lord.

Ezekiel 15:1-3 And the word of the LORD came unto me, saying: Son of man, what is the vine-tree more than any tree, the vine branch which grew up among the trees of the forest? Shall wood be taken thereof to make any work? or will men take a pin of it to hang any vessel thereon?

Ezekiel 15:6-8 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD: As the vine-tree among the trees of the forest, which I have given to the fire for fuel, so do I give the inhabitants of Jerusalem. And I will set My face against them; out of the fire are they come forth, and the fire shall devour them; and ye shall know that I am the LORD, when I

set My face against them. And I will make the land desolate, because **they have acted treacherously**, saith the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 16:1-3 Again the word of the LORD came unto me, saying: 'Son of man, cause **Jerusalem** to know her abominations, and say: Thus saith the Lord GOD unto Jerusalem: Thine origin and **thy nativity is of the land of the Canaanite; the Amorite was thy father, and thy mother was a Hittite.**

Ezekiel 16:4-6 And as for thy nativity, in the day thou wast born thy navel was not cut, neither wast thou washed in water for cleansing; thou was not salted at all, nor swaddled at all. No eye pitied thee, to do any of these unto thee, to have compassion upon thee; but thou wast cast out in the open field in the loathsomeness of thy person, in the day that thou wast born. And when I passed by thee, and saw thee wallowing in thy blood, I said unto thee: In thy blood, live; yea, I said unto thee: In thy blood, live;

Ezekiel 16:9-13 Then washed I thee with water; yea, I cleansed away thy blood from thee, and I anointed thee with oil. I clothed thee also with richly woven work, and shod thee with sealskin, and I wound fine linen about thy head, and covered thee with silk. I decked thee also with ornaments, and I put bracelets upon thy hands, and a chain on thy neck. And I put a ring upon thy nose, and earrings in thine ears, and a beautiful crown upon thy head. Thus wast thou decked with gold and silver; and thy raiment was of fine linen, and silk, and richly woven work; thou didst eat fine flour, and honey, and oil; and thou didst wax exceeding beautiful, and thou wast meet for royal estate.

Ezekiel 16:14,15 And thy renown went forth among the nations for thy beauty; for it was perfect, through My splendour which I had put upon thee, saith the Lord GOD. But thou didst trust in thy beauty and play the harlot because of thy renown, and didst pour out they harlotries on every one that passed by; his it was.

Ezekiel 16:16-19 And thou didst take of thy garments, and didst make for thee high places decked with divers colours, and didst play the harlot upon them; the like things shall not come, neither shall it be so. Thou didst also take thy fair jewels of My gold and of My silver, which I had given thee, and madest for thee images of men, and didst play the harlot with them; and thou didst take thy richly woven garments and cover them, and didst set Mine oil and Mine incense before them. My bread also which I gave thee, fine flour, and oil, and honey, wherewith I fed thee, thou didst even set it before them for a sweet savour, and thus it was; saith the Lord GOD.

Song of Solomon 4:16-5:1a Awake, O north wind; and come, thou south; blow upon my garden, that the spices thereof may flow out.

Let my beloved come into his garden, **and eat his precious** fruits. I am come into my garden, my sister, my bride; I have gathered my myrrh with my spice; I have eaten my honeycomb with my honey; I have drunk my wine with my milk.

Ezekiel 16:20,21 Moreover thou hast taken thy sons and thy daughters, whom thou hast borne unto Me, and these hast thou sacrificed unto them to be devoured. Were thy harlotries a small matter, that thou hast slain My children, and delivered them up, in setting them apart unto them?

Ezekiel 16:44,45 Behold, everyone that useth proverbs shall use this proverb against thee, saying, As is the mother, so is her daughter. Thou art thy mother's daughter, that loatheth her husband and her children; and thou art the sister of thy sisters, which loathed their husbands and their children: your mother was an Hittite, and your father an Amorite.

Ezekiel 16:46,47 And thine **elder sister is Samaria**, she and her daughters that dwell at thy left hand: and thy **younger sister, that dwelleth at thy right hand, is Sodom** and her daughters. Yet hast thou not walked after their ways, nor done after their abominations: but, as if that were a very little thing, thou wast corrupted more than they in all thy ways.

Ezekiel 16:48-50 As I live, saith the Lord GOD, Sodom thy sister hath not done, she nor her daughters, as thou hast done, thou and thy daughters. Behold, this was the iniquity of thy sister Sodom, pride, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy. And they were haughty, and committed abomination before me: therefore I took them away as I saw good.

Ezekiel. 16:51,52 Neither hath Samaria committed half of thy sins; but thou hast multiplied thine abominations more than they, and hast justified thy sisters in all thine abominations which thou hast done. Thou also, which hast judged thy sisters, bear thine own shame for thy sins that thou hast committed more abominable than they: they are more righteous than thou: yea, be thou confounded also, and bear thy shame, in that thou hast justified thy sisters.

Ezekiel 16:60-63 Nevertheless I will remember my covenant with thee in the days of thy youth, and I will establish unto thee an everlasting covenant. Then thou shalt remember thy ways, and be ashamed, when thou shalt receive thy sisters, thine elder and thy younger: and I will give them unto thee for daughters, but not

by thy covenant. And I will establish my covenant with thee; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD: That thou mayest remember, and be confounded, and never open thy mouth any more

because of thy shame, when I am pacified toward thee for all that thou hast done, saith the Lord GOD.
