## TORAH PORTION

**Exodus 27:20,21** And you shall command the children of Israel, that they bring you pure oil olive beaten for the light, to cause the lamp to burn always. In the tabernacle of the congregation without the veil, which is before the testimony, **Aaron** and his sons shall order it from evening to morning before the LORD: it shall be a statute for ever to their generations on the behalf of the children of Israel.

**Exodus 28:1,2** Bring **Aaron** your brother, and his sons with him, near to you from among the children of Israel, that he may minister to me in the priest's office, even **Aaron**, Nadab and Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar, **Aaron's** sons. You shall make holy garments for **Aaron** your brother, for glory and for beauty.

**Exodus 32:32** Yet now, if thou wilt forgive their sin; and if not, blot me, I pray thee, out of thy book which thou hast written.

**Exodus 28:9-12** And you shall take two onyx stones, and you shall engrave on them the names of the sons of Israel. Six of their names shall be on one stone, and six of the remaining names on the other stone, **according to their birth**. With the work of an engraver in stone, like the engravings of a signet, you shall engrave the two stones with the names of the sons of Israel. You shall make them to be set in settings of gold. And you shall put the two stones upon the shoulders of the ephod for stones of memorial to the sons of Israel. And Aaron shall bear their names before the LORD upon his two shoulders for a memorial.

**Exodus 28:15** You shall make a breastplate of judgment, the work of the skillful workman; like the work of the ephod you shall make it; of gold, of blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen, you shall make it.

**Exodus 28:21** The stones shall be according to the names of the children of Israel, twelve, according to their names; like the engravings of a signet, everyone according to his name, they shall be for the twelve tribes.

**Exodus 29:19,20** You shall take the other ram, and Aaron and his sons shall lay their hands on the head of the ram, and you shall kill the ram and take part of its blood and put it on the tip of the right ear of Aaron and on the tips of the right ears of his sons, and on the thumbs of their right hands and on the great toes of their right feet, and throw the rest of the blood against the sides of the altar.

**Exodus 29:38,39** Now this is that which you shall offer on the altar; two lambs of the first-year day by day continually. The one lamb you shall offer in the morning; and the other lamb you shall offer at even.

**Exodus 29:42-46** This shall be a continual burnt offering throughout your generations at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the LORD: where I will meet you, to speak there to you. And there I will meet with the children of Israel, and the tabernacle shall be sanctified by my glory. And I will sanctify the tabernacle of the congregation, and the altar: I will sanctify also both Aaron and his sons, to minister to me in the priest's office. And I will dwell among the children of Israel, and will be their God. And they shall know that I am the LORD their God, that brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell among them: I am the LORD their God.

**Exodus 30:7,8** And **Aaron** shall burn thereon sweet incense every morning: when he dresses the lamps, he shall burn incense on it. And when **Aaron** lights the lamps at even, he shall burn incense on it a perpetual incense before the LORD throughout your generations.

**Exodus 30:10** Aaron shall make atonement on its horns once a year. With the blood of the sin offering of atonement he shall make atonement for it once in the year throughout your generations. It is most holy to the Lord.

**Exodus 30:11-16** The Lord said to Moses, When you take the census of the people of Israel, then each shall give a ransom for his life to the Lord when you number them, that there be no plague among them when you number them. Each one who is numbered in the census shall give this: half a shekel according to the shekel of the sanctuary (the shekel is twenty gerahs), half a shekel as an offering to the Lord. Everyone who is numbered in the census, from twenty years old and upward,

shall give the Lord's offering. The rich shall not give more, and the poor shall not give less, than the half shekel, when you give the Lord's offering to make atonement for your lives. **You shall take the atonement money from the people of Israel and shall give it for the service of the tent of meeting**, that it may bring the people of Israel to remembrance before the Lord, so as to make atonement for your lives.

**Matthew 17:24-27** And when they were come to Capernaum, they that received the half-shekel came to Peter, and said, Does not your teacher pay the half-shekel? He said, Yea. And when he came into the house, Yeshua spoke first to him, saying, What do you think, Simon? The kings of the earth, from whom do they receive toll or tribute? From their sons, or from strangers? And when he said, From strangers, Yeshua said unto him, Therefore the sons are free. But lest we cause them to stumble, go thou to the sea, and cast a hook, and take up the fish that first cometh up; and when thou hast opened his mouth, thou shalt find a shekel: that take, and give unto them for me and thee.

**1 Samuel 15:2,3** Thus says the LORD of Hosts, I have marked that which Amalek did to Israel, how he set himself against him in the way, when he came up out of Egypt. Now go and strike Amalek, and utterly destroy all that they have, and don't spare them.

**1 Samuel 15:8,9** He took **Agag** the king of the Amalekites alive, and utterly destroyed all the people with the edge of the sword. But Saul and the people spared Agag, and the best of the sheep, and of the cattle, and of the fatlings, and the lambs, and all that was good, and wouldn't utterly destroy them: but everything that was vile and refuse, that they destroyed utterly.

**1 Samuel 15:10,11** The word of the Lord came to Samuel: I regret that I have made Saul king, for he has turned back from following me and has not performed my commandments. And Samuel was angry, and he cried to the Lord all night.

**1 Samuel 15:13-15** Samuel came to Saul; and Saul said to him, You are blessed by the LORD! I have performed the commandment of the LORD. Samuel said, Then what does this bleating of the sheep in my ears, and the lowing of the cattle

which I hear mean? Saul said, They have brought them from the Amalekites; for the people spared the best of the sheep and of the cattle, to sacrifice to the LORD your God. We have utterly destroyed the rest.

**1 Samuel 15:19-21** Why then didn't you obey the voice of the LORD, but took the spoils, and did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD? Saul said to Samuel, But I have obeyed the voice of the LORD, and have gone the way which the LORD sent me, and have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and have utterly destroyed the Amalekites. But the people took of the spoil, sheep and cattle, the chief of the devoted things, to sacrifice to the LORD your God in Gilgal.

**1 Samuel 15:24,25** Saul said to Samuel, I have sinned; for I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and your words, because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice. Now therefore, please pardon my sin, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD.

**1 Samuel 15:26-29** Samuel said to Saul, I will not return with you; for you have rejected the word of the LORD, and the LORD has rejected you from being king over Israel. As Samuel turned about to go away, Saul grabbed the skirt of his robe, and it tore. Samuel said to him, The LORD has torn the kingdom of Israel from you this day, and has given it to a neighbor of yours who is better than you.

**1 Samuel 15:30** Then he said, I have sinned: yet please honor me now before the elders of my people, and before Israel, and come back with me, that I may worship the LORD your God.

**Deuteronomy 25:17** Remember what Amalek did to you on the way as you came out of Egypt, how he attacked you on the way when you were faint and weary, and cut off your tail, those who were lagging behind you, and he did not fear God. Therefore when the Lord your God has given you rest from all your enemies around you, in the land that the Lord your God is giving you for an inheritance to possess, you shall blot out the memory of Amalek from under heaven; you shall not forget.

**1 Samuel 9:1,2a** Now there was a man of Benjamin, whose name was Kish, the son of Abiel, the son of Zeror, the son of Becorath, the son of Aphiah, the son of a Benjamite, a mighty man of valor. He had a son, whose name was Saul.

**Esther 2:5** There was a certain Jew in the citadel of Susa, whose name was Mordecai, the son of Jair, the son of Shimei, the son of Kish, a Benjamite,

**Esther 3:10** The king took his ring from his hand, and gave it to Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, the Jews' enemy.

**Daniel 8:27** And I Daniel **fainted, and was sick** certain days; afterward I rose up, and did the king's business; and I was astonished at the vision, but **none understood it**.

**Daniel 11:1** Also I in the first year of Darius the Mede, even I, **stood to confirm and to strengthen him**.

**Daniel 11:36-39** And the king shall do as he wills. He shall exalt himself and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak astonishing things against the God of gods. He shall prosper till the indignation is accomplished; for what is decreed shall be done. He shall pay no attention to the gods of his fathers, or to the one beloved by women. He shall not pay attention to any other god, for he shall magnify himself above all. He shall honor the god of fortresses instead of these. A god whom his fathers did not know he shall honor with gold and silver, with precious stones and costly gifts. He shall deal with the strongest fortresses with the help of a foreign god. **Those who acknowledge him he shall load with honor. He shall make them rulers over many and shall divide the land for a price.**

**Daniel 11:40-45** At the time of the end, the king of the south (Egypt) shall attack him, but the king of the north (Seleucids) shall rush upon him like a whirlwind, with chariots and horsemen, and with many ships. And he shall come into countries and shall overflow and pass through. He shall come into the glorious land. And tens of thousands shall fall, but these shall be delivered out of his hand: Edom and Moab and the main part of the Ammonites. He shall stretch out his hand against the countries, and the land of Egypt shall not escape. He shall become ruler of the treasures of gold and of silver, and

all the precious things of Egypt, and the Libyans and the Cushites shall follow in his train. But news from the east and the north shall alarm him, and he shall go out with great fury to destroy and devote many to destruction. And he shall pitch his palatial tents between the sea and the glorious holy mountain. Yet he shall come to his end, with none to help him.

**Daniel 10:1-4** In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia **a word was revealed to Daniel**, who was named Belteshazzar. And the **word was true**, and it was a great conflict. And **he understood the word and had understanding of the vision**. In those days I, Daniel, was **mourning for three weeks**. I ate no delicacies, no meat or wine entered my mouth, nor did I anoint myself at all, for the full three weeks. On the **twenty-fourth day of the first month**, as I was standing on the bank of **the great river (that is, the Tigris)**.

**Isaiah 44:28-45:1** Who says of Cyrus, He is my shepherd, and he shall fulfill all my purpose; saying of Jerusalem, She shall be built, and of the temple, Your foundation shall be laid. Cyrus, God's Instrument Thus says the LORD to his anointed, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have grasped, to subdue nations before him and to loose the belts of kings, to open doors before him that gates may not be closed.

**Ezra 4:1-5** Now when the adversaries of Judah and Benjamin heard that the returned exiles were building a temple to the LORD, the God of Israel, they approached Zerubbabel and the heads of fathers' houses and said to them, Let us build with you, for we worship your God as you do, and we have been sacrificing to him ever since the days of Esarhaddon king of Assyria who brought us here. But Zerubbabel, Jeshua, and the rest of the heads of fathers' houses in Israel said to them, You have nothing to do with us in building a house to our God; but we alone will build to the LORD, the God of Israel, as King Cyrus the king of Persia has commanded us. Then the people of the land discouraged the people of Judah and made them afraid to build and bribed counselors against them to frustrate their purpose, all the days of Cyrus king of Persia, even until the reign of Darius king of Persia.

**Daniel 10:5-8** I lifted up my eyes and looked, and behold, **a man** clothed in linen, with a **belt of fine gold** from Uphaz around his waist. His body was like beryl, **his face like the appearance**

**of lightning, his eyes like flaming torches, his arms and legs like the gleam of burnished bronze, and the sound of his words like the sound of a multitude.** And I, **Daniel, alone saw the vision**, for the men who were with me did not see the vision, but a great trembling fell upon them, and they fled to hide themselves. So I was left alone and saw this great vision, and no strength was left in me. My radiant appearance was fearfully changed, and I retained no strength.

**Revelation 1:12,15** Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking to me, and on turning I saw seven golden lampstands, and in the midst of the lampstands one like a son of man, clothed with a long robe and with a golden sash around his chest. The hairs of his head were white, like white wool, like snow. **His eyes were like a flame of fire, his feet were like burnished bronze**, refined in a furnace, and **his voice was like the roar of many waters.**

**Ezekiel 1:26-28** And on the top of the arch which was over their heads was the form of a king's seat, like a sapphire stone; and on the form of the seat was the form of a man seated on it on high. And I saw it colored like electrum, with the look of fire in it and round it, going up from what seemed to be the middle of his body; and going down from what seemed to be the middle of his body I saw what was like fire, and there was a bright light shining round him. Like the bow in the cloud on a day of rain, so was the light shining round him. And this is what the glory of the Lord was like. And when I saw it, I went down on my face, and the voice of one talking came to my ears.

**Daniel 10:9-12** Then I heard the sound of his words, and as I heard the sound of his words, I fell on my face in deep sleep with my face to the ground. And behold, a hand touched me and set me trembling on my hands and knees. And he said to me, O Daniel, **man greatly loved**, understand the words that I speak to you, and stand upright, for now I have been sent to you. And when he had spoken this word to me, I stood up trembling. Then he said to me, "Fear not, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand and humbled yourself before your God, your words have been heard, and I have come because of your words.

**Daniel 10:13,14** The prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days, but Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I was left there with the kings of Persia, and came to make you understand what is to happen to your people in the latter days. For the vision is for days yet to come.

**Daniel 10:15-17** When he had spoken to me according to these words, I turned my face toward the ground and was mute. And behold, one in the likeness of the children of man touched my lips. Then I opened my mouth and spoke. I said to him who stood before me, O my lord, by reason of the vision pains have come upon me, and I retain no strength. How can my lord's servant talk with my lord? For now no strength remains in me, and no breath is left in me.

**Daniel 10:18-20** Again one having the appearance of a man touched me and **strengthened me**. And he said, **O man greatly loved** fear not, peace be with you; **be strong and of good courage**. And as he spoke to me, **I was strengthened** and said, Let my lord speak, for you have **strengthened me**. Then he said, Do you know why I have come to you? But now I will return to fight against the prince of Persia; and when I go out, behold, the prince of Greece will come.

**Daniel 10:21** But I will tell you what is inscribed in the book of truth: there is none who contends by my side against these **except Michael, your prince**.

**Daniel 9:25-27** Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times. And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined. And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

**Daniel 12:1-4** And at that time shall **Michael stand up**, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be **a time of trouble**, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time **thy people shall be delivered**, every one that shall be found written in the book. And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever. But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro and knowledge shall be increased.

**Jeremiah 30:6,7** Ask ye now, and see whether a man doth travail with child? Wherefore do I see every man with his hands on his loins, as a woman in travail, and all faces are turned into paleness? Alas! for that day is great, so that none is like it: it is even the **time of Jacob's trouble; but he shall be saved out of it.**

**Daniel 12:5-7** Then I, Daniel, looked, and behold, **two others stood**, one on this bank of the stream and one on that bank of the stream. And someone said to the man clothed in linen, **who was above the waters of the stream**. How long shall it be till the end of these wonders? And I heard the man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the stream; he raised **his right hand and his left hand** toward heaven **and swore** by him who lives forever that it would be for **a time, times, and half a time**, and that **when the shattering of the power of the holy people comes to an end** all these things would be finished.

**Deuteronomy 32:36** For the LORD will **vindicate his people** and have compassion on his servants, **when he sees that their power is gone** and there is none remaining, bond or free.

**Revelation 10:1-6** And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire: And he had in his hand a little book open: and he set his right foot upon the sea, and his left foot on the earth, And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices. And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to

write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, **Seal up those things** which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not. And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up his hand to heaven, And swore by him that liveth for ever and ever, who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are, and the sea, and the things which are therein, that there should be time no longer.

**Daniel 12:8-13** I heard, but I did not understand. Then I said, O my lord, **what shall be the outcome of these things?** He said, **Go your way, Daniel, for the words are shut up and sealed until the time of the end.** *Many shall purify themselves and make themselves white and be refined, but the wicked shall act wickedly. And none of the wicked shall understand, but those who are wise shall understand.* And from the time that the **regular burnt offering is taken away and the abomination that makes desolate is set up, there shall be 1,290 days.** Blessed is he who waits and arrives at the **1,335** days. But go your way till the end. And you shall rest and shall stand **in your allotted place** at the end of the days.

**Revelation 22:8-13** And I John saw these things, and heard them. And when I had heard and seen, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel which shewed me these things. Then saith he unto me, See thou do it not: for I am thy fellow servant, and of thy brethren the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: worship God. And he saith unto me, **Seal not the sayings of the prophecy of this book:** for the time is at hand. He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still. And **behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.** I am Aleph and Tav, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.

**Isaiah 62:10-12** Go through, go through the gates; prepare ye the way of the people; cast up, cast up the highway; gather out the stones; lift up a standard for the people. Behold, the LORD hath proclaimed unto the end of the world, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, **Behold, thy salvation cometh; behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him.** And they shall call them, The holy people, The redeemed of the LORD: and thou shalt be called, Sought out, A city not forsaken.

**Ephesians 2:10** For **we are his workmanship**, created in Messiah Yeshua unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.
