TORAH PORTION

Leviticus 21:1,2 And the LORD said to Moses, **Speak to the priests the sons of Aaron**, and say unto them, There shall **none be defiled for the dead** among his people: except for his relatives that are near to him: for his mother, for his father, for his son, for his daughter, for his brother,

Leviticus 21:16-18 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to Aaron, saying, Whoever he be of your seed in their generations **that has any blemish, let him not approach to offer the bread** of his God. For whatever man he be that has **a blemish**, he shall not approach.

Leviticus 22:31,32 Therefore you shall keep my commandments, and do them. I am the LORD. You shall not profane my holy name, but I will be made holy among the children of Israel. **I am the LORD who makes you holy**, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God. I am the LORD.

Leviticus 22:20 But whatever has a blemish that shall you not offer: for it shall not be acceptable for you.

Malachi 1:8,9 When you offer the blind for sacrifice, isn't that evil? And when you offer the lame and sick, isn't that evil? Present it now to your governor! Will he be pleased with you? Or will he accept your person? says the LORD of Hosts. Now, please entreat the favor of God, that he may be gracious to us. With this, will he accept any of you? says the LORD of Hosts.

Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

Ephesians 5:25-27 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it, that he might **sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word**, That he might present it to himself a glorious church, **not having spot, or wrinkle**, or any such thing; but that it **should be holy and without blemish**.

Leviticus 21:19-21 a blind man, or a lame, or he that hath a flat nose, or anything superfluous, Or a man that is broken footed, or broken handed, Or crookback, or a midget, or that hath a blemish in his eye, or be scurvy, or scabbed, or hath his stones broken,

No man that hath a blemish of the seed of Aaron the priest shall come nigh to offer the offerings of the Lord made by fire, he hath a blemish, he shall not come nigh to offer the bread of his God.

I. Blind (can't see your condition)

Revelation 3:17-18 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing, and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and **blind**, and naked. I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich, and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear, and anoint thine eyes with **eyesalve**, that thou mayest see.

2 Peter 1:3-9 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the **knowledge of him** that hath called us to glory and virtue: Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, and to virtue knowledge, and to knowledge temperance, and to temperance patience, and to patience godliness, and to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness charity. For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be **barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ**. But he that **lacks these things is blind**, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

1 John 2:9-11 He that saith he is in the light, and **hateth** his brother, is in darkness even until now. He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him. But he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness **hath blinded his eyes**.

2 Corinthians 3:13-14 And not as Moses, which put a vail over his face, that the children of Israel could not steadfastly look to the end of that which is abolished: But their **minds** were **blinded**: for until this day remains the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament, which vail is done away in Christ.

2 Corinthians 4:3-4 But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: In whom the god of this world hath **blinded the minds** of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

Ephesians 4:17-18 This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the **blindness** of their **heart**:

II. Lamé (legs disabled or of unequal lengths)

2 Samuel 4:4 And Jonathan, Saul's son, had a son that **was lame** of his feet. He was five years old when the tidings came of Saul and Jonathan out of Jezreel, and his nurse took him up, and fled: and it came to pass, as she made haste to flee, that he fell, and became **lame**. And his name was Mephibosheth.

Job 29:12-15 Because I delivered the poor that cried, and the fatherless, and him that had none to help him. The blessing of him that was ready to perish came upon me: and I caused the widow's heart to sing for joy. I put on righteousness, and it clothed me: my judgment was as a robe and a diadem. **I was eyes to the blind, and feet was I to the lame.**

Proverbs 26:7 The legs of the lame are not equal: so is a parable in the mouth of fools.

Ezekiel 18:23-25 Have I any pleasure at all that the wicked should die? saith the Lord GOD: and not that he should return from his ways, and live? But when the righteous turneth away from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, and doeth according to all the abominations that the wicked man doeth, shall he live? All his righteousness that he hath done shall not be mentioned: in his trespass that he hath trespassed, and in his sin that he hath sinned, in them shall he die. Yet ye say, The way of the Lord is **not equal**. Hear now, O house of Israel, Is not my way equal? Are **not your ways unequal?**

III. Flat nose (No spiritual Discernment)

Song 7:4 Thy neck is as a tower of ivory, thine eyes like the fishpools in Heshbon, by the gate of Bath-rabbim: **thy nose is as the tower of Lebanon** which looketh toward Damascus.

Job 27:1-3 Moreover Job continued his parable, and said, As God liveth, who hath taken away my judgment, and the Almighty, who hath vexed my soul; All the while my breath is in me, and the **spirit of God is in my nostrils**.

Hebrews 5:12-14 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God, and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their **senses** exercised to **discern** both good and evil.

Hebrews 4:12-13 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a **discerner** of the thoughts and intents of the heart

Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight: but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do.

1 Corinthians 2:9-14 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for **the Spirit** searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? Even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God. Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are **spiritually discerned**.

IV. Anything superfluous: (Adding to the Word of God)

Deuteronomy 4:2 Ye shall **not add** unto the word which I command you, **neither shall ye diminish** ought from it, that ye

may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you.

Prov 30:5-6 Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him. **Add thou not unto his words**, lest he reprove thee, and thou be found a liar.

Revelation 22:18-19 For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If **any man shall add** unto these things, God shall **add unto him the plagues** that are written in this book: And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

V. Broken foot: Your walk and ability to stand

Isaiah 65:1-2 I am sought of them that asked not for me, I am found of them that sought me not: I said, Behold me, behold me, unto a nation that was not called by my name. I have spread out my hands all the day unto a rebellious people, which **walketh in a way** that was not good, after their own thoughts.

Jeremiah 10:23 O LORD, I know that the way of man is not in himself: it is not in man **that walketh to direct his steps**.

Psalms 119:103-105 How sweet are thy words unto my taste! yea, sweeter than honey to my mouth! Through thy precepts I get understanding: therefore I hate every false way. **Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path**.

VI. Broken hand: (Your works, ability to handle things)

2 Corinthians 4:2 But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor **handling the word of God deceitfully**, but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

Jeremiah 2:8 The priests said not, Where is the LORD? and **they that handle the law knew me not**: the pastors also transgressed against me, and the prophets prophesied by Baal, and walked after things that do not profit.

Matthew 7:21-22 Not everyone that **saith unto me, Lord, Lord,** shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done **many wonderful works?**

Titus 1:16 They profess that they know God, but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.

PSALM 119

Samech, Ayin, Peh, Tsade

Psalm 119:113 **SAMECH** I am a hater of twisted and perverse thoughts, but I am a lover of your law.

Psalm 119:114 You are my hiding place and my shield against danger, my hope is in your Word.

Genesis 15:1 After these things the word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision: Fear not, Abram, I am your shield, your reward shall be very great.

Psalm 119:115 Depart from me, ye evildoers, that I may keep the commandments of my God.

Psalm 22:16 For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have enclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet.

Psalm 27:1,2 The LORD is my light and my salvation, whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life, of whom shall I be afraid? When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell.

Psalm 119:116,117 Uphold me according unto thy word, that I may live, and let me not be ashamed of my hope. Hold thou me up, and I shall be safe, And shall have respect unto thy statutes continually.

Leviticus 18:5 So keep my rules and my decisions, which, if a man does them, will be life to him: I am the Lord.

Psalm 54:4 See, God is my helper: the Lord is the great supporter of my soul.

Psalm 37:23-25 The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord, and he takes delight in his way. Even if he has a fall he will not be without help: for the hand of the Lord is supporting him. I have been young, and now am old, but I have not seen the good man without help, or his children looking for bread.

Isaiah 41:10-14 Have no fear, for I am with you; do not be looking about in trouble, for I am your God, I will give you strength, yes, I will be your help, yes, my true right hand will be your support. Truly, all those who are angry with you will be made low and put to shame: those desiring to do you wrong will come to nothing and never again be seen. You will make search for your haters but they will not be there, those who make war against you will be as nothing and will come to destruction. For I, the Lord your God, have taken your right hand in mine, saying to you, Have no fear, I will be your helper. Have no fear, you worm Jacob, and you men of Israel, I will be your helper, says the Lord, even he who takes up your cause, the Holy One of Israel.

Psalm 119:118-120 You spurn all who go astray from your statutes, for their cunning is in vain. All the wicked of the earth you discard like dross, therefore I love your testimonies. **My flesh trembles** for fear of you, and I am afraid of your judgments.

Psalm 119:121,122 AYIN I have done justice and righteousness, leave me not to mine oppressors. **Be surety for Thy servant** for good, let not the proud oppress me.

Isaiah 56:1,2 Thus says the LORD: Keep justice, and do righteousness, for soon my salvation will come, and my righteousness be revealed. Blessed is the man who does this, and the son of man who holds it fast, who keeps the Sabbath, not profaning it, and keeps his hand from doing any evil.

Genesis 44:32 For thy servant became surety for the lad unto my father, saying: If I bring him not unto thee, then shall I bear the blame to my father forever.

Psalm 119:123,124 My eyes long for your salvation and for the fulfillment of your righteous promise. Deal with your servant according to your steadfast love, and teach me your statutes.

Psalm 119:125,126 I am your servant, give me understanding, that I may know your testimonies! **It is time for the LORD to act, for your law has been broken.**

Psalm 119:127,128 Therefore I love your commandments above gold, above fine gold. Therefore I consider all your precepts to be right, I hate every false way.

Psalm 119:129 PEH Your testimonies are wonderful, therefore my soul keeps them.

Psalm 119:130 The **unfolding of your words gives light**, it imparts understanding to the simple.

Psalm 119:131,132 I open my mouth and pant, because I long for your commandments. Turn to me and **be gracious to me**, as is your way with those who **love your name**.

Psalm 119:133-135 Keep steady my steps according to your promise, and let no iniquity get dominion over me. Redeem me from man's oppression, that I may keep your precepts. **Make your face shine upon** your servant, and **teach me your statutes**.

Exodus 3:2-4 And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush, and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed. And Moses said: I will turn aside now, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said: 'Moses, Moses. And he said: Here am I.

Psalm 1:3 Happy is the man who does not go in the **company of sinners**, or take his place in the **way of evil-doers**, or in the seat of those **who do not give honour** to the Lord. **But whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and whose mind is on his law day and night**. He will be like a tree planted **by the rivers of water**, which gives its fruit at the right time, whose leaves will ever be green; and he will do well in all his undertakings.

Psalm 119:136 **Rivers of water are flowing from my eyes**, because men **do not keep your law**.

Genesis 6:6 And it repented the LORD that He had made man on the earth, and it grieved Him at His heart.

Deuteronomy 5:29 Oh that they had such a heart as this always to fear Me, and keep all My commandments, that it might be well with them, and with their children forever!

1 John 5:2,3 In this way, we are certain that we have love for the children of God, when we have love for God and keep his laws. For loving God is keeping his laws: and his laws are not hard.

Lamentations 3:46-50 The mouths of all our haters are open wide against us. Fear and deep waters have come on us, wasting and destruction. Rivers of water are running down from my eyes, for the destruction of the daughter of my people. My eyes are streaming without stopping, they have no rest, till the Lord's eye is turned on me, till he sees my trouble from heaven.

Psalm 119:137,138 **TZADE** O Lord, great is your **righteousness**, and upright are your decisions. You have given your unchanging word in **righteousness**, and it is forever.

Deuteronomy 16:20 Righteousness--righteousness shall you pursue, so that you may live, and possess the land which the LORD your God is giving to you.

Psalm 119:139,140 My passion has overcome me, because **my haters are turned away from your words. Your word is of tested value**, and it is dear to your servant.

Deuteronomy 8:10-14 And thou shalt eat and be satisfied, and bless the LORD thy God for the good land which He hath given thee. **Beware lest thou forget** the LORD thy God, in not keeping His commandments, and His ordinances, and His statutes, which I command thee this day, lest when thou hast eaten and art satisfied, and hast built goodly houses, and dwelt therein, and when thy herds and thy flocks multiply, and thy silver and thy gold is multiplied, and all that thou hast is multiplied, then thy heart be lifted up, and thou forget the LORD thy God, who brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

Psalm 12:6 The words of the Lord are **true words: like silver tested by fire** and burned clean seven times. You will keep

them, O Lord, you will keep them safe from this generation forever. The sinners are walking on every side, and evil is honoured among the children of men.

Psalm 18:30 As for God, his way is completely good; **the word of the Lord is tested**, he is a breastplate for all those who put their faith in him.

Psalm 119:141,142 **I am small and of no account**, but I keep your orders in mind. Your righteousness is an unchanging righteousness, and your law is certain.

Psalm 119:143,144 Pain and trouble have overcome me: but your teachings are my delight. The righteousness of your unchanging word is eternal, give me wisdom so that I may have life.
