



## TORAH PORTION

**Deuteronomy 32:2** My doctrine shall drop as the rain, my speech shall distil as the dew; as the small rain upon the tender grass, and as the showers upon the herb.

**Hosea 6:3** And let us know, eagerly strive to know the LORD, His going forth is sure as the morning; and He shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter rain that watereth the earth.'

**Ezekiel 34:26** And I will make them and the places round about My hill a blessing; and I will cause the shower to come down in its season; there shall be showers of blessing.

**Zechariah 14:9** The LORD will be King over all the earth. In that day the LORD will be one, and his name one.

**Zechariah 14:16,17** And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations that came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and **to keep the feast of tabernacles**. And it shall be, that whoso of the families of the earth goeth not up unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, upon them there shall be no rain.

**John 7:2** Now the Jewish festival, the Feast of Sukkot, was at hand.

**John 7:14** But when it was now the midst of the feast, Yeshua went up into the temple and taught.

**Psalm 118:14,15** *The LORD is my strength and song, and is become my salvation.* The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tabernacles of the righteous: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly.

**Psalm 118:25,26** Save now, I beseech you, O LORD: O LORD, I beseech you, send now prosperity. Blessed be he that comes in the name of the LORD: we have blessed you out of the house of the LORD.

**John 7:37,38** Now on the last and greatest day of the feast, Yeshua stood and cried out, "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink! He who believes in me, as the Scripture has said, from within him will flow rivers of living water."

**Isaiah 12:2,3** Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation. Therefore with joy shall you draw water out of the wells of salvation.

**Isaiah 12:6** Cry aloud and shout, you inhabitant of Zion; for the Holy One of Israel is great in the midst of you!"

**Deuteronomy 33:1** And this is the blessing, with which Moses the man of God **blessed the children of Israel** before his death.

**Luke 24:50,51** And he led them out until they were over against Bethany: and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them. And it came to



pass, while he blessed them, he parted from them, and was carried up into heaven.

**Jeremiah 23:29** Is not my word like as a fire? said the LORD; and like a hammer that breaks the rock in pieces?

**Proverbs 6:23** For the commandment is a lamp, And the law a light;

**Deuteronomy 33:2-4** He said, "The LORD came from Sinai, And rose from Seir to them. He shone forth from Mount Paran. He came from the ten thousands of holy ones. At his right hand was a fiery law for them. Yes, he loves the people. All his holy ones are in your hand. They sat down at your feet; each receives your words. Moses commanded us a law, An inheritance for the assembly of Jacob.

**Deuteronomy 33:5** He was king in Jeshurun, When the heads of the people were gathered, All the tribes of Israel together.

**Deuteronomy 33:13-16** And of Joseph he said, Blessed of the LORD be his land, for the precious things of heaven, for the dew, and for the deep that coucheth beneath, And for the precious fruits brought forth by the sun, and for the precious things put forth by the moon, And for the chief things of the ancient mountains, and for the precious things of the lasting hills, And for the precious things of the earth and fullness thereof, and for the good will of him that dwelled in the bush: let the blessing come on the head of Joseph, and on the top of the head of him that was separated from his brothers.

**Deuteronomy 33:26-29** "There is none like God, Jeshurun, who rides on the heavens for your help, In his excellency on the skies. The eternal God is your dwelling place. Underneath are the everlasting arms. He thrust out the enemy from before you, and said, 'Destroy!' Israel dwells in safety; the fountain of Jacob alone, In a land of grain and new wine. Yes, his heavens drop down dew. You are happy, Israel. Who is like you, a people saved by the LORD, the shield of your help, the sword of your excellency! Your enemies shall submit themselves to you. You shall tread on their high places."

**Deuteronomy 34:1a** Then Moses went up from the plains of Moab to Mount Nebo, to the top of Pisgah, which is across from Jericho.

**Deuteronomy 34:4,5** Then the Lord said to him, "This is the land of which I swore to give Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, saying, 'I will give it to your descendants.' I have caused you to see it with your eyes, but you shall not cross over there." So Moses the servant of the Lord died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the Lord.

**Deuteronomy 34:8-12** And the children of Israel wept for Moses in the plains of Moab thirty days. So the days of weeping and mourning for Moses ended. Now Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom, for Moses had laid his hands on him; so the children of Israel heeded him, and did as the Lord had commanded Moses. But since then there has not arisen in Israel a prophet like Moses, whom the



Lord knew face to face, in all the signs and wonders which the Lord sent him to do in the land of Egypt, before Pharaoh, before all his servants, and in all his land, and by all that mighty power and all the great terror which Moses performed in the sight of all Israel.

**Acts 1:9-11** And when he had said these things, as they were looking, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight. And while they were looking steadfastly into heaven as he went, behold two men stood by them in white apparel; who also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye looking into heaven? this Yeshua, who was received up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye beheld him going into heaven.

**Ezekiel 38:1-3** And the word of the LORD came to me, saying, Son of man, set your face against Gog, the *land of Magog*, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal, and prophesy against him, And say, Thus said the Lord GOD; Behold I am against you, *O Gog*, the *chief prince of Meshech and Tubal*:

**Deuteronomy 22:8** When you build a new house, then you shall make a battlement for your roof,

**Ezekiel 39:17-21** And, you son of man, thus said the Lord GOD; Speak to every feathered fowl, and to every beast of the field, Assemble yourselves, and come; gather yourselves on every side to my sacrifice that I do sacrifice for you, even a great sacrifice on the mountains of Israel, that you may eat flesh, and drink blood. You shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes of the earth, of rams, of lambs, and of goats, of bullocks, all of them fatted calves of Bashan. And you shall eat fat till you be full, and drink blood till you be drunken, of my sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you. Thus you shall be filled at my table with horses and chariots, with mighty men, and with all men of war, said the Lord GOD. And I will set my glory among the heathen, and all the heathen shall see my judgment that I have executed, and my hand that I have laid on them.

**Revelation 19:17,18** And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the middle of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together to the supper of the great God; That you may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

**Joshua 1:1-3** After the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, it came to pass that the Lord spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, saying: "Moses My servant is dead. Now therefore, arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them—the children of Israel. Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given you, as I said to Moses.

**Joshua 1:6-9** "Be strong and courageous; for you shall cause this



people to inherit the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. Only be strong and very courageous, to observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded you. Don't turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may have good success wherever you go. This scroll of the Torah shall not depart out of your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then you shall make your way prosperous, and then you shall have good success. Haven't I commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Don't be afraid, neither be dismayed: for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

**Joshua 1:16-18** So they answered Joshua, saying, "All that you command us we will do, and wherever you send us we will go. Just as we heeded Moses in all things, so we will heed you. Only the Lord your God be with you, as He was with Moses. Whoever rebels against your command and does not heed your words, in all that you command him, shall be put to death. Only be strong and of good courage."

**Genesis 1:1-3** In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Now the earth was formless and empty. Darkness was on the surface of the deep. God's Spirit was hovering over the surface of the waters. God said, "Let there be light," and there was light.

## SPOTS

**James 1:27** Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself **unspotted** from the world.

**Eph 5:25-27** Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; That he might **sanctify and cleanse it** with **the washing of water by the word**, That he might present it to himself a glorious church, **not having spot, or wrinkle**, or any such thing; but that it **should be holy and without blemish**.

**2 Peter 3:10-14** But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up. Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness, Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat? Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness. Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, **without spot**, and blameless.

**2 Peter 2:10-16** But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous are they, selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities. Whereas angels,



which are greater in power and might, bring not railing accusation against them before the Lord. But these, as natural brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed, speak evil of the things that they understand not; and shall utterly perish in their own corruption; And shall receive the reward of unrighteousness, as they that count it pleasure to riot in the day time. **Spots they are and blemishes**, sporting themselves with their own deceivings while they feast with you; Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling unstable souls: an heart they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children: Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following **the way of Balaam** the son of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness; But was rebuked for his iniquity: the dumb ass speaking with man's voice forbad the madness of the prophet.

**Jude 1:11-13** Woe unto them! For they have gone in **the way of Cain**, and ran greedily after **the error of Balaam for reward**, and perished in the **gainsaying of Core**. **These are spots** in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds they are without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots; Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever.

**Jude 1:23** Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. And of some have compassion, making a difference: And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment **spotted** by the flesh.

**1 John 2:16** For all that is in the world, the *lust of the flesh*, and the *lust of the eyes*, and the *pride of life*, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

**Genesis 4:1-16** And Adam knew Eve his wife; and she conceived, and bare Cain, and said, I have gotten a man from the LORD. And she again bare his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground. And in process of time it came to pass, that **Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the LORD**. And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering: But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. **And Cain was very wrath**, and his countenance fell. And the LORD said unto Cain, Why art thou wrath? And why is thy countenance fallen? If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? And if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him. And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that **Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him**. And the LORD said unto Cain, Where is Abel thy brother? And **he said, I know not: Am I my brother's keeper?** And he said, What hast thou done? The voice of thy brother's blood crieth unto me from the ground. And now art thou cursed from the earth. which hath



opened her mouth to receive thy brother's blood from thy hand; When thou tillest the ground, it shall not henceforth yield unto thee her strength; **a fugitive and a vagabond shalt thou be** in the earth. And **Cain said unto the LORD, My punishment is greater than I can bear.** Behold, thou hast driven me out this day from the face of the earth; and from thy face shall I be hid; and I shall be a fugitive and a vagabond in the earth; and it shall come to pass, that every one that findeth me shall slay me. And the LORD said unto him, Therefore whosoever slayeth Cain, vengeance shall be taken on him sevenfold. And the LORD set a mark upon Cain, lest any finding him should kill him. And Cain went out from the presence of the LORD, and dwelt in the land of Nod, on the east of Eden.

**1 John 3:10-14** In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever **doeth not righteousness** is not of God, neither **he that loveth not his brother.** For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another. Not as **Cain**, who was of that wicked one, and slew his brother. And **wherefore slew he him?** Because **his own works were evil, and his brother's righteous.** Marvel not, my brethren, if the world hate you. We know that we have passed **from death unto life**, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death.

**James 1:27 Pure religion and undefiled** before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself **unspotted** from the world.

**Galatians 5:19-21** Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, **hatred**, variance, emulations, **wrath, strife**, seditions, heresies, **Envyings, murders**, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

**2 Peter 2:12-16** But these, as natural brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed, speak evil of the things that they understand not; and shall utterly perish in their own corruption; And shall receive the reward of unrighteousness, as they that count it pleasure to riot in the day time. **Spots they are** and blemishes, sporting themselves with their own deceivings while they feast with you; **Having eyes full of adultery**, and that cannot cease from sin; **beguiling unstable souls**: an heart they have exercised with **covetous practices**; cursed children: Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the **way of Balaam** the son of Bosor, who **loved the wages of unrighteousness**; But was rebuked for his iniquity: the dumb ass speaking with man's voice forbad the madness of the prophet.

**Num 22:4-6** And Moab said unto the elders of Midian, Now shall this company lick up all that are round about us, as the ox licketh up the grass of the field. And Balak the son of Zippor was king of the



Moabites at that time. He sent messengers therefore unto Balaam the son of Beor to Pethor, which is by the river of the land of the children of his people, to call him, saying, Behold, there is a people come out from Egypt: behold, they cover the face of the earth, and they abide over against me: Come now therefore, I pray thee, curse me this people; for they are too mighty for me: peradventure I shall prevail, that we may smite them, and that I may drive them out of the land: for I wot that he whom thou **blessest is blessed**, and he **whom thou cursest is cursed**.

**James 3:8-11** But the tongue can no man tame; it is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison. Therewith bless we God, even the Father; and therewith curse we men, which are made after the similitude of God. **Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing.** My brethren, these things ought not so to be. Doth a fountain send forth at the same place sweet water and bitter?

**Numbers 22:12-22** And God said unto Balaam, Thou shalt not go with them; thou shalt not curse the people: for they are blessed. And Balaam rose up in the morning, and said unto the princes of Balak, Get you into your land: for the LORD refuseth to give me leave to go with you. And the princes of Moab rose up, and they went unto Balak, and said, Balaam refuseth to come with us. And Balak sent yet again princes, more, and more honourable than they. And they came to Balaam, and said to him, Thus saith Balak the son of Zippor, Let nothing, I pray thee, hinder thee from coming unto me: For I will promote thee unto very great honour, and I will do whatsoever thou sayest unto me: come therefore, I pray thee, curse me this people. And Balaam answered and said unto the servants of Balak, If Balak would give me his house full of silver and gold, I cannot go beyond the word of the LORD my God, to do less or more. Now therefore, I pray you, tarry ye also here this night, that I may know what the LORD will say unto me more. And God came unto Balaam at night, and said unto him, If the men come to call thee, rise up, and go with them; but yet the word which I shall say unto thee, that shalt thou do. And Balaam rose up in the morning, and saddled his ass, and went with the princes of Moab. And God's anger was kindled because he went: and the angel of the LORD stood in the way for an adversary against him. Now he was riding upon his ass, and his two servants were with him.

**Numbers 31:16** Behold, these caused the children of Israel, through the counsel of Balaam, to commit trespass against the LORD in the matter of Peor, and there was a plague among the congregation of the LORD.

**Revelation 2:12-14** And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write; These things saith he which hath the sharp sword with two edges; I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, even where Satan's seat is: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr,



who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth. But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.

**Numbers 16:1-3** Now **Korah, the son of Izhar, the son of Kohath, the son of Levi**, and Dathan and Abiram, the sons of Eliab, and On, the son of Peleth, **sons of Reuben**, took men: And **they rose up before Moses**, with certain of the children of Israel, two hundred and fifty princes of the assembly, famous in the congregation, men of renown: And they gathered themselves together against Moses and against Aaron, and said unto them, Ye take too much upon you, seeing all the congregation are holy, every one of them, and the LORD is among them: wherefore then lift ye up yourselves above the congregation of the LORD?

**Exodus 6:16-21** And these are the names of the **sons of Levi** according to their generations; Gershon, and **Kohath**, and Merari: and the years of the life of Levi were an hundred thirty and seven years. The sons of Gershon; Libni, and Shimi, according to their families. And the **sons of Kohath; Amram, and Izhar**, and Hebron, and Uzziel: and the years of the life of Kohath were an hundred thirty and three years. And the sons of Merari; Mahali and Mushi: these are the families of Levi according to their generations. And **Amram** took him Jochebed his father's sister to wife; and she **bare him Aaron and Moses**: and the years of the life of Amram were an hundred and thirty and seven years. And **the sons of Izhar; Korah**, and Nepheg, and Zichri.

**Numbers 16:8-10** And Moses said unto Korah, Hear, I pray you, ye sons of Levi: Seemeth it but a small thing unto you, that the God of Israel hath separated you from the congregation of Israel, to bring you near to himself to do the service of the tabernacle of the LORD, and to stand before the congregation to minister unto them? And he hath brought thee near to him, and all thy brethren the sons of Levi with thee: and **seek ye the priesthood also?**

**Numbers 16:12-14** And Moses sent to call **Dathan and Abiram**, the sons of Eliab: which said, We will not come up: Is it a small thing that thou hast brought us up out of a land that floweth with milk and honey, **to kill us** in the wilderness, except **thou make thyself altogether a prince over us?** Moreover thou hast not brought us into a land that floweth with milk and honey, or given us inheritance of fields and vineyards: wilt thou put out the eyes of these men? We will not come up.

**Exodus 2:13-14** And when he went out the second day, behold, **two men of the Hebrews** strove together: and he said to him that did the wrong, Wherefore smitest thou thy fellow? And he said, **Who made thee a prince and a judge over us? Intendest thou to kill**



me, as thou killedst the Egyptian? And Moses feared, and said, Surely this thing is known.

**Numbers 16:19-21** And Korah gathered all the congregation against them unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation: and the glory of the LORD appeared unto all the congregation.
