Exodus 24:18 “So Moses went into the midst of the cloud and went up into the mountain. And Moses was on the mountain forty days and forty nights.”

Exodus 32:2 “And he received *the gold* from their hand, and he fashioned it with an engraving tool, and made a molded calf. “Then **they** said, “This *is your* god, O Israel, that brought you out of the land of Egypt!””

Exodus 32:4 “And he received *the gold* from their hand, and he **fashioned** it with an **engraving tool**, and made a molded calf.”

2 Kings 5:23 “So Naaman said, “Please, take two talents.” And he urged him, and **bound** two talents of silver in two **bags**, with two changes of garments, and handed *them* to two of his servants; and they carried *them* on ahead of him.”

Judges 17:1-6 “Now there was a man from the mountains of Ephraim, whose name *was* Micah.

² And he said to his mother, “The eleven hundred *shekels* of silver that were taken from you, and on which you put a curse, even saying it in my ears—here *is* the silver with me; I took it.”

And his mother said, “*May you be* blessed by the Lord, my son!” ³ So when he had returned the eleven hundred *shekels* of silver to his mother, his mother said, “I had wholly dedicated the silver from my hand to the Lord for my son, to make a carved image and a molded image; now therefore, I will return it to you.” ⁴ Thus he returned the silver to his mother. Then his mother took two hundred *shekels* of silver and gave them to the silversmith, and he made it into a carved image and a molded image; and they were in the house of Micah.

⁵ **The man Micah had a shrine and made an ephod and household idols**; and he consecrated one of his sons, who became his priest. ⁶ In those days *there was* no king in Israel; everyone did *what was* right in his own eyes.”

2 Timothy 3:8-9 “Now as **Jannes and Jambres** resisted Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, disapproved concerning the faith; ⁹ but they will progress no further, for their folly will be manifest to all, as theirs also was.”

Matthew 6:9 “In this manner, therefore, pray: **Our Father in heaven**, Hallowed be Your name.”

John 14:13-14 “And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. ¹⁴ If you **ask anything in My name**, I will do *it*.” Context, context, context! Back up one verse: “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater *works* than these he will do, **because I go to My Father.**”

Exodus 35:1: “Moses assembled [*vayakhel*] the entire Israelite congregation”.

Session 2

Exodus 38:21 These are the **accounts** of the tabernacle, even the tabernacle of the testimony, as they were rendered according to the commandment of Moses, through the service of the Levites, by the hand of Ithamar, the son of Aaron the priest.

Romans 14:12 “So then each one of us will give account of himself to God.”

Ephesians 5:15,16 “Look therefore carefully how ye walk, not as unwise, but as wise; **redeeming the time**, because the days are evil.”

Luke 16:10,11 “He who is faithful in a very little is faithful also in much. He who is dishonest in a very little is also dishonest in much. If therefore you have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches?”

Matthew 25:14,15 “For it is like a man, **going into another country**, who called his own servants, and entrusted his goods to them. To one he gave **five talents**, to another two, to another one; to each according to his own ability. **Then he went on his journey.**”

Matthew 20:1 “For the kingdom of heaven is like unto a man that was a householder, who went out early in the morning to **hire laborers** into his vineyard.”

Matthew 20:10,11 “But when the first came, they supposed that they should have received more; and they likewise received every man a penny. And when they had received it, they murmured against **the goodman of the house.**”

Exodus 40:25 “And he **lit the lamps** before the LORD; as the LORD commanded Moses.”

Exodus 40:34,35 “Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. **And Moses was not able to enter** into the tent of the congregation, because the cloud stayed thereon, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.”

Isaiah 66:22-24 “For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain. And it shall come to pass, that from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the LORD. And they shall go forth, and look upon the carcases of the men that have transgressed against me: for their worm shall not die, neither shall their fire be quenched; and they shall be an abhorring unto all flesh.”

1Chronicles 28:11,12 “**Then David gave to Solomon his son the pattern of the porch,** and of the houses thereof, and of the treasuries thereof, and of the upper chambers thereof, and of the inner parlours thereof, and of the place of the mercy seat, And the pattern of all that **he had by the spirit,** of the courts of the house of the LORD, and of all the chambers round about, of the treasuries of the house of God, and of the treasuries of the dedicated things:”

1Kings 8:7,8 “For the cherubim spread forth their wings over the place of the ark, and the cherubim covered the ark and the staves thereof above. **And the staves were so long that the ends of the staves were seen from the holy place, even before the Sanctuary; but they could not be seen without; and there they are unto this day.**”

1Kings 11:5-8 “For Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, and after Milcom the abomination of the Ammonites. And Solomon did evil in the sight of the LORD, and went not fully after the LORD, as did David his father. Then did Solomon build an high

place for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that is before Jerusalem, and for Molech, the abomination of the children of Ammon. And likewise did he for all his strange wives, which burnt incense and sacrificed unto their gods.”

1Kings 11:9-11 “And the LORD was angry with Solomon, because his heart was turned from the LORD God of Israel, which had **appeared unto him twice**, And had commanded him concerning this thing, that he should not go after other gods: but he kept not that which the LORD commanded. Wherefore the LORD said unto Solomon, Forasmuch as this is done of thee, and thou hast not kept my covenant and my statutes, which I have commanded thee, I will surely rend the kingdom from thee, and will give it to thy servant.”
